When the world is turning on each other in anger, let's turn on each other in love. Because they will know we are Christians by our love...



### Financial News:

**Thank you for your continued financial support** during this time! We know that many of you have added stress, expenses and maybe a decrease or loss of income right now, which makes your gifts even more meaningful.

We received our **quarterly interest payment** from the Trust Fund Investment (aka American National) in the amount of \$1,232.56. 1/3 goes to building maintenance, 1/3 to the Council Discretionary fund, 1/6 to world hunger and 1/6 to Lutheran Social Service.

Our Sept **VISA bill** included a charge of \$86 that most likely stemmed from a fraudulent phishing scam. The credit card company has been notified, and they plan to reimburse the \$86. They also cancelled our credit card and are issuing a new one, as an added precaution.

Our commitment of \$1,000 was sent in support of **missionary, Karen Anderson**, in Sept.

**Fall insect spraying** was done at church and the parsonage, to be split between Maintenance expenses and the Parsonage Expense Fund.

As of Sept. 25, the **PPP loan forgiveness application process is still on hold**. We've been assured that the deadline to apply for forgiveness will be extended in accordance with the date we actually can apply. We're keeping a close eye on it and really hoping to get it forgiven by the end of the year.
