LENT and REPENTANCE

Lent is the time for us to respond to that urgent appeal of Christ to *repent* for our sins and failings. Christ's appeal is urgent. Such repentance is not simply a one-off event, but is a way of life, a daily turning of the whole of our lives to the Lord, who alone can lead us to the promised land of eternal life. The warning is clear – though we Christians are baptised and eat the spiritual food and drink that IS Christ, we must be careful not to fall. Remember the fig tree: if it fails to bear fruit, it will be cut down, removed from the vineyard, which is the ancient symbol of the promised land. In this season of grace, God is acting.
