We will form a *Parish Survey Group* for this purpose and plan a reflection on our Parish strengths and challenges and write a *Mission Readiness Statement* detailing this by September. The Archdiocese will review all Mission Statements and make determinations of Parish viability We hope to hold "listening sessions" with key groups of the parish in next month If you can help we need you!
