From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

Last Sunday, January 10 we celebrated the Baptism of the Lord, traditionally the Nativity scene is kept for 40 days until the Presentation of the Lord on February 2. This Sunday we begin the liturgical season of the Church, Ordinary Time, that does not focus upon one specific moment of Jesus' life.

In the first reading we hear of the Prophet Samuel as a child growing up in the temple of the Lord. The book of Samuel reads, "At that time Samuel was not familiar with the Lord, because the Lord had not revealed anything to him as yet." The readings today provoke us to question our "familiarity" with the Lord. It is interesting to note that the Hebrew root word that is used is ya-da', which means "to know". In scripture "to know" implies not a knowledge, but a personal and intimate relation. The readings tell us of a willingness "to know" who is the Lord; whether it be the attentiveness of Samuel even while he was asleep, or the eagerness of the disciples to stay the night with the Lord. Let us ask the Lord that we may also come to know him, "For [we] have been purchased at a price.

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

El pasado domingo 10 de enero celebramos el Bautismo del Señor, tradicionalmente el belén se guarda durante 40 días hasta la Presentación del Señor el 2 de febrero. Este domingo damos inicio al tiempo litúrgico de la Iglesia, Tiempo Ordinario, que no se enfoca en un momento específico de la vida de Jesús.

En la primera lectura escuchamos del profeta Samuel cuando era un niño que crecía en el templo del Señor. El libro de Samuel dice: "En ese momento, Samuel no estaba familiarizado con el Señor, porque el Señor aún no le había revelado nada". Las lecturas de hoy nos incitan a cuestionar nuestra "familiaridad" con el Señor. Es interesante notar que la palabra raíz hebrea que se usa es ya-da', que significa "conocer". En las escrituras, "conocer" implica no un conocimiento, sino una relación personal e íntima. Las lecturas nos hablan de la voluntad de "saber" quién es el Señor; ya sea la atención de Samuel incluso mientras dormía, o el anhelo de los discípulos por pasar la noche con el Señor. Pidamos al Señor que también podamos llegar a conocerlo, "porque [nosotros] hemos sido comprados por un precio.

Queridos irmãos e irmãs,

No último domingo, 10 de janeiro, celebramos o Batismo do Senhor, tradicionalmente o presépio é mantido por 40 dias até a Apresentação do Senhor no dia 2 de fevereiro. Neste domingo iniciamos o tempo litúrgico da Igreja, o tempo comum, que não enfoca em um momento específico da vida de Jesus.

Na primeira leitura, ouvimos sobre o Profeta Samuel como uma criança crescendo no templo do Senhor. O livro de Samuel diz: "Naquela época, Samuel não estava familiarizado com o Senhor, porque o Senhor ainda não havia revelado nada a ele". As leituras de hoje nos levam a questionar nossa "familiaridade" com o Senhor. É interessante notar que a raiz hebraica usada é ya-da', que significa "saber". Nas escrituras, "conhecer" não implica um conhecimento, mas uma relação pessoal e íntima. As leituras nos falam de uma disposição de "saber" quem é o Senhor; seja a atenção de Samuel mesmo enquanto ele dormia, ou a ânsia dos discípulos de passar a noite com o Senhor. Peçamos ao Senhor que também possamos conhecê-lo: "Porque [nós] fomos comprados por um preço.
