NWD Fall Youth Retreat – Details & Information

- **When & Where:** Friday, December 5th – Sunday, December 7th at Teen Quest (teenquest.org). Teen Quest is located at 293 Rich Road, Somerset, PA 15501.
 - When traveling to Teen Quest, refer to the Teen Quest website for specific directions as a GPS may not be accurate for the last few miles of the trip (teenquest.org/about/directions-to-the-teen-quest-ranch).
- **Who:** The Next Level youth retreat is for students in 7th – 12th grade.
- **Cost:** \$135.00 per person. Cost includes: lodging, five meals, activities at Teen Quest Ranch, powerful services & ministry, lots of laughs & tons of memories. *Dinner will not be provided on Friday Dec. 5th, so be sure to eat before arriving.*
- **Registration:** Individual registrations are available through your Youth Leader OR at northwesterndistrict.com. Please refer to the “How to Register” info sheet on the district website for full registration details.
- **Arrival / Departure:** Registration runs on Friday, December 5th from 5 pm – 8 pm. Opening service is at 8:30 pm. The retreat concludes on Sunday, December 7th at 1 pm, directly following lunch. *Each group must depart at that time.*
- **Packing:** See the “Packing List” form for details on what to bring!
- **Activities:** Teen Quest offers a wide-range of fun activities for students that are all available during free time at The Next Level: paintball, horseback riding, indoor skate park, indoor rock wall, indoor high ropes challenge, archery, Gagaball, basketball, snowboarding & snow tubing (weather contingent), and more!
- **Spending Money:** Campers may want to bring spending money as there will be opportunities to give offerings at the services. Also, there will be snacks & drinks available for purchase at the Teen Quest “Tin Spur” throughout the weekend. *If playing paintball, initial paintballs are covered in the registration fee, but extra paintballs can be purchased at \$5 for 100.
- **Rules & Regulations:** Specific rules are given at the retreat. Lack of cooperation, unnecessary roughness, lack of respect to property or an unwholesome attitude on the part of any student will result in removal from the retreat. No refund will be given and transportation of a removed student will be decided between their parent & youth ministry leader.
- **Late Arrivals / Early Departures:** Either of these need arranged between the parents of the student and their respective Youth Leader.
