RESPONDING TO THE COMPASSIONATE CHRIST

In the Gospel today Jesus invites himself to Zacchaeus' house. Those who knew this tax collector were horrified. Jesus often behaves in ways that others would not contemplate. His invitations to conversion were often accepted but on some occasions were rejected. On one occasion Jesus invited a rich young man to follow him but he was unable to give up his wealth and the security it afforded him in order to answer Jesus' call. Zacchaeus, however, did respond positively. He knew that what Jesus was offering was worth so much more than the money he had. He realised that it could not bring him peace and so he chose to depend on God instead of money. Zacchaeus can probably be a good example for us to follow.

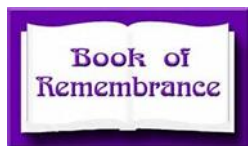
