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TREASURER'S REPORT

School is back in session and we are having a great year so far! Our first General PTA Meeting was August 25, 2015. At this meeting the budget was presented and approved for Budget income of \$51,300 and Budget Expense of \$52,914. As of our September General PTA meeting, total year to date (YTD) expenses are \$7,933.78 and total YTD income is \$4,404.22. Expenses since the beginning of the school year include \$5,720.23 in Enrichment Programs, \$110.54 in Fundraisers, \$223.17 in Hospitality, \$1,060.99 in Membership which includes PTA Info night and Staff Membership Luncheon, and \$618.85 in Operational Costs which include communication and copies.

YTD income includes a \$1,000.00 Harvest Festival sponsor, \$2,168.44 in Easy Money Programs such as Raley's Extra Credit for \$1,121.80, Jamba Juice and eScrip. The Easy Money Program is already proving to be a great source of income for our PTA. Please be sure to link your Raley's/BelAir card to Coyote Ridge Elementary. It is free money for our kids and the great programs your PTA provides for them.

We are looking forward to our Jog-A-Thon fundraiser on September 28. We projected to raise \$10,000 from this fundraiser and hope we exceed this amount!

WHAT IS THE TEAL PUMPKIN PROJECT?

The Teal Pumpkin Project is a national campaign that helps raise awareness of food allergies and promotes inclusion of all trick-or-treaters. Consider the young trick-or-treater who comes to your door just as excited as his friends to fill his bag with yummy treats. As you toss a peanut butter cup or a Snickers bar in his bag, he knows that that's one more treat he'll have to give away or throw in the trash. This stress and feeling of exclusion can be very disappointing for a child.
