### What is VRAP?





- •VRAP is apart of the VOW to Hire Heroes Act of 2011 that will begin on July 1, 2012
- •**Purpose**: To offer 12 months of training assistance to unemployed Veterans
- •Applications: submitted through the Department of Labor (DoL) and benefits paid by the VA
- •**Payments**: receive up to 12 months of assistance at the full-time rate under Montgomery GI-Bill-Active Duty (\$1,473 per mo.)

#### •Programs:

- •must be VA approved program at a community college or technical school
- Program leading to an Associates, Non-College Degree, or Certification



#### •To qualify, a Veteran must:

- ■Be between 35 60 years old
- Be unemployed (determined by DoL)
- Have an other than dishonorable discharge
- •Not be eligible for any other VA education program (e.g. Post-9/11 GI Bill, Vocational Rehabilitation and Employment Assistance)
- Not in receipt of VA compensation due to unemployability
- Not enrolled in a federal/state job training program



•Effective January 23, 2012, Chapter 35 claimants may receive payments via direct deposit





# Interval Pay Changes

# According to Public Law 111-377 effective August 1, 2011:

### No More Interval "Break" Payment:

 Break payments are <u>no longer payable</u> <u>under any VA education benefit program</u> unless under an Executive Order of the President due to an emergency situation such as a natural disaster or strike
