Lesson Commentary: Dedicating our lives to holiness – a way of life, in service for our Lord!

Praying, fasting, lifting up and opening our mouths to lost and dying world. The coming of Christ, His return is so close at hand. Who can we tell? Who can we share with? As we yield ourselves to the discipline of the Word, surrender out desires to align with His, He will grant us the desires of our hearts (Psalms 37:4-5).

Lesson Commentary:

Holiness means being totally devoted and dedicated to God, set apart from sin and its influence. As we daily give ourselves to the practice of holy living, we will develop and express ourselves less and reflect and resemble God's qualities in our lives more. Holiness causes our focus and priorities to develop more and more upon our Lord. This kind of life is not accomplished/developed on its own or through our own efforts. God aids us by providing the Holy Spirit to obey and overcome sin. Call on Him! He can free you from sin's grip. Everything in life – possessions, accomplishments, people – will eventually fade away. We must stop grasping the temporary and focus our time, money, and energy on the permanent – the Word of God, His way of living, and Eternal life.
