The AARC-EVAC™ system provides unique advantages to Community Health Centres:

- The system facilitates rapid response to medical and OVA incidents at reception, in consultation rooms, and across the entire facility via customised, and if desired discrete, voice, tone and visual messaging.
- Wireless design allows simple deployment of up to a total of 14 alarm messages, which includes 12 S.O.S. zones (Duress and/or First Aid) with unique assistance call messages in new or existing facilities, the system includes fixed and/or portable transmitters.
- System design and installation is simple, minimising cost and disruption.
- Installation savings can exceed 60% compared to hard wired/cabled systems.

First Aid

Lockdown

Provide Lockdown messages to secure buildings against external threats.



Evacuation

Evacuation Siren with Voice Messages, providing improved access to triggers and clear evacuation instructions.

Duress

Single or Multiple Alert Panels can trigger a zoned message, customised to call for assistance to its particular zone. Up to 12 customised S.O.S. message zones can be established within each system.

First Aid

In the event of an accident, injury or medical incident, triggering the First Aid button will call for assistance to that location. Up to 12 customised S.O.S. message zones can be established within each system.

Lockdown

In the event of an external threat, Lockdown triggers a covert recorded message or a public warning signalling personnel to begin a lockdown procedure.

Evacuation

Triggers Australian Standard Evacuation Tones plus a customised recorded voice message delivering instructions on evacuation of the premises and the assembly point.

Note: The number of available S.O.S. message zones are divided between First Aid and Duress.
