The SAGE is set on the banks of the famous Quayside of the river Tyne and provides a superb modern venue for a meeting that aims to present the best of GI endoscopy.

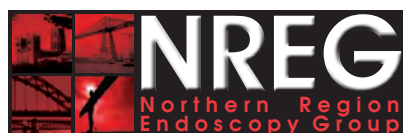
I would warmly encourage you to attend this exciting meeting and register early to avoid disappointment.
