## JESUS IS OUR ONLY RECONCILLATION UNTO THE FATHER

Far beyond the ancient past the angel Lucifer, whom God had created, became filled with self pride corrupting himself unto rebellion against the eternal living God, his creator. As a result Lucifer became the devil and Satan. He also persuaded a third of the other angels of heaven with him in his rebellion.

Here in Genesis 3:1, God identified him as "the serpent".

Now the serpent was more subtil (deceptive) than any beast of the field which the LORD God had made. (And "the serpent, Satan, the devil" deceived Eve into disobeying/rebelling against the LORD God, and Eve encouraged Adam with her, in her disobedience. And they both (two agreed and) disobeyed the LORD God; thereby causing the fall of mankind into sin.

And the woman said unto the serpent, We may eat of the fruit of the trees of the garden: But of the fruit of the tree which is in the midst of the garden, God hath said, Ye shall not eat of it, neither shall ye touch it, lest ye die (notice: even now Eve has somehow gained misinformation. God said to dress and keep the garden, but they were not to eat of the tree of knowledge of good and evil. There was no command not to touch. One would think to dress and keep the garden may require touching the tree at some point?).

And the serpent said unto the woman, Ye shall not surely die:

For God doth know that in the day ye eat thereof, then your eyes shall be opened, and ye shall be as gods, knowing good and evil.

And when the woman saw that the tree *was* good for food, and that it *was* pleasant to the eyes, and a tree to be desired to make *one* wise, she took of the fruit thereof, and did eat, and gave also unto her husband with her; and he did eat.

And the eyes of them both were opened, and they knew that they *were* naked; and they sewed fig leaves together, and made themselves aprons.

And they heard the voice of the LORD God walking in the garden in the cool of the day: and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the LORD God amongst the trees of the garden.

And the LORD God called unto Adam, and said unto him, Where art thou?

And he said, I heard thy voice in the garden, and I was afraid, because I was naked; and I hid myself.

And he said, Who told thee that thou *wast* naked? Hast thou eaten of the tree, whereof I commanded thee that thou shouldest not eat?

And the man said, The woman whom thou gavest *to be* with me, she gave me of the tree, and I did eat.

And the LORD God said unto the woman, What *is* this *that* thou hast done? And the woman said, The serpent beguiled me, and I did eat.

But the LORD God chose to redeem fallen man and the woman by sending his own Son in the flesh, blood, and bone man Jesus Christ, who has paid the penalty (in His day of human ministry and flesh) on a cross for Adam's disobedience (sin) that put Adam and all mankind after him under sin. But now everyone of the human race may choose to be redeemed through Christ Jesus; who is "Son of the living God".

And the LORD God said unto the serpent, Because thou hast done this, thou *art* cursed above all cattle, and above every beast of the field; upon thy belly shalt thou go, and dust shalt thou eat all the days of thy life:

And I will put enmity between thee and the woman, and between thy seed and her seed; it (seed of the woman) shall bruise thy head, and thou shalt bruise his heel.
