Public Access Computers/Wi-Fi Policy

1. Public access computers are available for use during regular library hours. If the user is under the age of 12, a parent or guardian must be present in the library. If the user is under the age of 5, a parent or guardian must sit at the computer with them. This rule applies for our literacy stations [children's computers] as well. Please ask for extended time should you need it to work on school/job related work.
2. There is no charge for computer usage. The fee for printing is **25¢ per page**.
3. Wi-Fi access is available **6:00 AM—9:00 PM**. Please choose the **"Middleton Public"** connection to access our public network. This connection is public and does **not** require you to have a passcode.
4. We also remind you that it is against our internet use policy to use our network for any purpose that violates applicable federal, state, or local laws including copyright laws, that interferes with or disrupts other computer users, services, or equipment, or attempts to gain unauthorized entry to other computing, information, or communications sources or devices (hacking).
5. Parents are cautioned to monitor their minor children's use of the internet.
