HANDICAP RULES

- All scores, regardless of where they are played, must be turned in for handicap by Sunday of the week in which they were played and must be adjusted according to the U.S.G.A. Equitable Stroke Control (see chart on page 5).
- Five eighteen-hole scores must be submitted to establish a handicap. Handicaps are based on the USGA handicapping system, using the lowest 10 of the last 20 scores posted.
- Only members with established handicaps from Brighton Park Golf Club will be allowed to compete in club tournaments commencing with Event #3, you cannot play the tournament and use the score for your fifth round.
- The Brighton Park Golf Course is rated as follows: Blue Tees -71,2/119: White Tees - 69.8/118.
- Scores for handicap only need not be attested.
- All scores must be posted including 9 hole scores online or on the computer in the clubhouse. The 5 designated tournaments must be entered as tournament scores
- 7. Handicaps will be changed on the 1st and 15th of the month
- Each member is responsible for checking his handicap before filling out his tournament card.
- 9. Handicap classes will be as follows:

Championship	Class 10 and under
"A"	Class 11 thru 14
"B"	Class 15 thru 19
"C"	Class 20 and above

- The Brighton Park Golf Club season will begin on April 21st and end September 24th.
- 11. Handicaps as of the 1st day of each tournament will be used
- Failure to comply with the above rules may result in a reduction of handicap.

Brighton Park Golf Club Local Rules - 2016

- 1. USGA rules govern all play
- 2. Refer to some format changes for 2016
- Out of bounds rule (any hole where stakes designate boundaries and as listed on scorecard)
 Rule explained as follows- stroke & distance penalty.

Out of bounds boundaries as follows:

- #1 white stakes right of hole
- #2 white stakes right & behind green
- #9 white stakes on right by embankment hill & toward driving range
- #10 white stakes behind green
- #13 white stakes behind green in woods
- #14 ball landing past white stakes to the right of ditch and landing / rolling up to far right side of rough & green guarding the residential homes
- #17 white stakes on right
- #18 white stakes on right near playground
- All parking lots & roads are out of bounds
- 4. All water hazards and other hazards will be played as lateral. Rule 26.1;

Add a stroke and drop / play ball behind hazard at closest point it entered. Lateral Hazards as follows:

- #3 Ditch crossing in front of tee box
- #10 Ditch on both sides of fairway
- #11 Oftch on both sides of fairway & Bird Sanctuary right of fairway past the ditch
- #12 Ditch crossing both sides of fairway and Tall Grass area behind green
- #13 Ditch crossing both sides of fairway & Bird Sanctuary on right past the ditch
- # 14 Ditch crossing both sides of fairway and ball landing/rolling in to ditch on right
- # 16 Ditch on far right Tall Grass area on far left
- #17 Ditch crossing in front of the tee box and Tall Grass area far left of green
- #18 Ditch crossing both sides of fairway and far left Tall Grass area past ditch
- Free relief from immovable man made obstructions. (building structures, benches,etc.) complete relief then 2 club lengths no closer to the hole.
- 6. New Local Rule for BPGC- repair/tap all spike marks on your line along with ball marks.
- 7. We will post & communicate summer or winter rules and Bunker play as committee makes decision via email/locker room posting/ starters shack posting. We will refer to USGA Rule 33-8A for determining if local abnormal conditions interfere with the proper playing of game.
- 8. Fix all divots & ball marks don't forget to rake traps
- 9. Carry your events booklet in your golf bag for all tourneys & rules information.
- 10. All disputes shall be referred to Tournament Committee in writing. All decisions are final.
