Your Polling Location

Accessibility





INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMBINATION FORM

All voters are required to have some form of acceptable identification. When a voter is accepted for voting under certain conditions of the law, the election official shall note the section of the Texas Election Code under which the voter was accepted. The following are explanations of those conditions and the section numbers of the laws that correspond with the explanations.

1. Voter (with acceptable identification) with Correct Certificate Who is Not on List:

Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006" next to the voter's name. Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List.

2. Voter (with acceptable identification) with Incorrect Certificate Who is Not on List:

Have voter initial the "Affidavit for Voter Not on List" box (near the voter's signature).

Check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006." Add voter's name to the Registration Omissions List. It is also necessary to indicate on the Registration Omissions List the precinct number as indicated on the voter's registration certificate.

3. Voter (with acceptable identification) whose Name on Identification is "Substantially Similar" to Name on the Official List of Registered Voters:

Have voter initial the "Similar Name Affidavit" box (near voter's signature). Check the box labeled "Similar Name 63.001(c)."

4. If a voter is unable to sign his or her name, an election official shall place the voter's name on the signature roster and make a notation as to the reason the voter is unable to sign.

INSTRUCTIONS

The Statement of Officer must be completed before the Constitutional Oath of Office is administered.

Each oath that is administered is valid for the duration of the election officer's term of office (if any) and shall be filed with the election records for the election in which the election officer is serving.

All oaths, affidavits, or affirmations made within this State may be administered and a certificate of the fact given by a judge, clerk, or commissioner of any court of record, a notary public, a justice of the peace, city secretary, and the Secretary of State of Texas

NEW LAW, HB 1735, 85th Legislature, 2017 – Under Section 1.016 of the Texas Election Code, Individuals that are authorized to administer the Oaths or statements required under the Texas Election Code or the Texas Constitution to election officers entering service includes the following:

- 1. The Secretary of State, member of the secretary of state's staff, or a state inspector appointed by the secretary,
- 2. A county of municipal clerk or the clerk's deputies,
- 3. A county tax assessor-collector of the county tax assessor-collector's deputies,
- 4. A city secretary,
- 5. A member of the county election commission or county election board,
- 6. A county elections administrator or employee of a county EA,
- 7. The Secretary of the governing body of a political subdivision other than a county or city or the authority performing the duties of secretary under this code,
- 8. A presiding election judge or alternative presiding judge who has already entered service,
- 9. An early voting clerk or a deputy early voting clerk who has already entered service;
- 10. A member of an early voting ballot board or signature verification committee who has already entered into service,
- 11. A presiding judge, manager, or tabulation supervisor of a central counting station who has already entered service.

Instructions: If a voter appears on the official list of registered voters, but does not possess an acceptable form of photo identification under Section 63.0101 (a) of the Texas Election Code (which, for voters aged 18-69, has expired by no more than four years, and for voters aged 70 or over, is or is not expired, if otherwise valid) ("Acceptable Photo ID"), and cannot reasonably obtain an Acceptable Photo ID, the following steps shall be taken by the election officer to allow the voter to cast a regular ballot:

- 1.Present this form to the voter, and ask the voter to provide a copy or original of one of the following forms of identification listed in Section 63.0101(b) of the Texas Election Code:
- a. a certified domestic (from a U.S. state or territory) birth certificate or a document confirming birth admissible in a court of law which establishes the voter's identity (which may include a foreign birth document);
- b. a current utility bill;
- c. a bank statement;
- d. a government check;
- e. a paycheck; or

 On the combination form, check the box labeled "Not on List 63.006" next to the voter's name. Add voter to Omissions
- 2. Voter (with required documentation) with Incorrect Certificate Who is Not on List:
 On the combination form, have voter initial the Voter's Affidavit "Not On List 63.006" box (near the voter's signature), and check the box labeled "Not On List 63.006." It is also necessary to indicate on the Omissions List the precinct number as indicated on the voter's certificate. Add voter's name to the Omissions List and check the box labeled "Not On List 63.006."

NOTE ABOUT AMENDMENTS:

"Required documentation" refers to acceptable voter ID. or documentation showing an acceptable exemption. A voter without this documentation will vote provisionally (unless the voter chooses to return later with documentation).



Provisional Ballots

• The following procedures apply to both early voting in person and election day.

Preparing the Polling Place

- The supplies sent to the polling place must include.
- The green Affidavit of Provisional Voter envelope.
- The white Secrecy Envelope.
- The Notice to Provisional Voter.
- The List of Provisional Voters.

The election judge should print and set aside a sufficient number of Provisional ballots.

- The ballots should be disarranged as to allow for a random numerical order.
- The provisional ballots should be kept separate from regular ballots to avoid a voter getting the incorrect ballot.



- Provisional voting occurs both during early voting in person and on election day.
- A provisional ballot must be offered to...

 - A voter who does not provide an acceptable form of identification.
 A voter whose name not an exact match or not substantially similar.
 A voter whose identity cannot be verified by the identification presented.
 - 4) A voter who has received a disability exemption under, but does not have voter régistration certificate indicating such exemption.
 - 5) A voter whose name does not appear on the list of registered voters and does not have a registration certificate, but states they are a registered and eligible voter of the precinct.
- 6) A voter who has applied for a ballot by mail, but has not yet properly cancelled the mail ballot application.
 - 7) A voter who votes during the polling hours that are extended by a state or federal court.
 - 8) A voter who is registered in another precinct other than the one the voter is registered.
 - 9) A voter who is on the precinct list of registered voters, but whose registered résidence address is outside the political subdivision for which the voter is seeking to vote.
 - 10) Other (with an explanation).

- If a voter fits into one of these categories, the election worker shall inform the voter of their right to cast a provisional ballot.
 - If the voter is not appearing on the list of registered voters, the election worker may assist the voter in determining if they are registered in another precinct Using an e-pollbook, or calling Voter Registrar.
- If the voter believes they are registered, the election judge must ask if the voter registered or updated their registration at DPS.
 - If voter did go to DPS, the election judge **must** note this and the approximate date the voter went to DPS on the green Affidavit of Provisional Voter envelope.
- Recommended Procedure
 - In addition to asking about DPS, it is okay for the Election Judge to ask additional information about when/how the voter believes they have registered:
 - When did you mail in your card?
- What was the name and/or location for which you registered through a VDR?
 All of these help the voter!!!
- If the voter is not appearing on the list of registered voters, the election worker should inform the voter that the ballot will only be counted if it is determined they are registered voter of the precinct.
 - If voter is casting a ballot due to lack of an acceptable ID, the election worker should inform the voter that the ballot will only be counted if the voter appears at the Voter Registrar and shows ID, or executes a temporary affidavit (if applicable), or permanent exemption (if applicable)

- After notifications...
 - 1. Voter should complete a green Affidavit of Provisional Voter envelope on the front side.
 - 2. Election Judge should complete their portion on the reverse side, and sign it.
 - 3. Election Judge should add voter's name to List of Provisional Voters/Early Voting List of Provisional Voters.
 - 4. Election judge should add name of voter to combination form/poll list, and indicate they are a provisional voter.
 - 5. Voter should sign the combination form/poll list.
 - 6. The election judge should provide a Notice to Provisional Voter to the voter.
- – The Voter should pick their own ballot from disarranged supply of provisional ballots.
 - Voter should mark their ballot, and then place inside the white Secrecy Envelope.



NOTICE TO PROVISIONAL VOTER

(For provisional voter who did not (1) present an acceptable form of photo ID and (2) complete a reasonable impediment declaration)

A determination whether your ballot will be counted will be made by the early voting ballot board after the election. A notice will be malled to you within 30 days of the election at the address you provided on your affidavit to vote a provisional ballot indicating either (1) that your ballot was counted or (2) if it was not counted, the reason your ballot was not counted.

If you are voting in the correct precinct, in order to have your provisional ballot accepted, you will be required to visit your local county voter registrar's office (information below) within six days of the date of the election to either present one of the below forms of photo ID OR submit one of the temporary affidavits addressed below (e.g., religious objection or natural disaster without an acceptable form of photo identification) in the presence of the county voter registrar OR submit the paperwork required to obtain a permanent disability exemption. The process can be expedited by taking this notice with you to the county voter registrar at the time you present your



acceptable form of photo identification (or execute your temporary affidavit or provide your paperwork for your permanent exemption); however, taking this notice is not a requirement.

Acceptable Forms of Photo Identification

- Texas Driver's License issued by the Department of Public Safety (DPS)
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS*;
- Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS;
- Texas Handgun License issued by DPS;
- United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph;
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph; or
- United States Passoon

"If you do not have another acceptable form of photo identification you may apply for a free Election Identification Certificate at your local Texas Department of Public Safety office.

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the identification must be current or have expired no more than 4 years before being presented for voter qualification at the polling place.

PERMANENT EXEMPTION

During the cure period, voters with a disability may apply with the county voter registrar for a <u>permanent exemption</u> to presenting acceptable photo identification in the county. The application must contain written documentation from either the U.S. Social Security Administration evidencing applicant's disability, or from the U.S. Department of Veterans Affairs evidencing disability rating of at least 50 percent. The applicant must also state that he/she has no valid form of acceptable photo identification. Those who obtain a disability exemption will be allowed to vote upon display of voter registration certificate reflecting the exemption.

TEMPORARY EXEMPTIO

During the cure period, a voter may apply for a temporary exemption at the county voter registrar's office for voters who have a consistent religious objection to being photographed OR who do not present an acceptable form of photo identification because of certain natural disasters as declared by the President of the United States or the Texas Governor.

Provisional Voter...continued

- Have the Voter complete the Provisional Voter Affidavit (green envelope)
- Provide the Voter with the Notice to Provisional Voter
- Add the Voters name to the List of Provisional Voters
- Give the Voter a ballot marked "Provisional"
- Have the Voter place the ballot in a SECRECY ENVELOPE
- Place the SECRECY ENVELOPE IN THE green envelope "Affidavit of Provisional Voter" Envelope
- Place the green envelope in the ballot box


Provisional Envelopes

Why is it important that provisional ballots be placed in a separate envelope?
The Answer is. Provisional ballots do not get counted on election nigh

The Answer is, Provisional ballots do not get counted on election night, and take a different route than all other ballots.

- After the polls close on election night, election judge should enter the number of provisional ballots on the Register of Official Ballots and the List of Provisional Voters.
- Election judge should place a copy of the List of Provisional Voters in the Envelope marked Provisional Ballot Affidavit, This envelope goes to the General Custodian.
- If the election judge returns voted ballots marked "provisional" that are not in the green Affidavit of Provisional Voter envelopes, the voter's registration/identification cannot be verified. These cannot be counted, and must be treated as "irregularly marked" ballots.

Health Protocols for Voting in Person

Practice Social Distancing

Please maintain at least 6 feet separation from other individuals when possible.

Wear a Mask or Face Covering

Face Coverings are Strongly Recommended but not required in the polling place.

You may have to lower or remove your mask temporarily if the election judge is unable to verify your identity.

Face Coverings are subject to the prohibition on electioneering for or against any candidate, measure, or political party.

Sanitize or Wash Your Hands

Please wash or sanitize your hands upon entering the polling place, after interacting with other individuals at the polling place, after using voting system equipment or marking a ballot, and upon exiting the polling place.

Curbside Voting

If you have signs or symptoms of COVID-19, please consider Curbside Voting.

People Allowed Inside the Polling Place

- A Voter
- Child accompanying a voter
- Person assisting the voter
- Person acting as voter's interpreter
- Election Judge/Alternate Judge/Clerk (MUST wear name tag)
- Poll Watcher who presents a valid Certificate of Appointment to the Presiding Election Judge (MUST wear a name tag)
- With Credentials
 - State Election Inspectors
 - Peace Officers summoned by Presiding Judge to preserve order
 - Secretary of State and his staff
 - Federal observers
 - Voting system technicians
 - Election Administration staff
 - Emergency personnel if needed

County Chairs in Polling Places

 The 83rd Legislature enacted Section 172.1113, which provides that a county chair may be in a polling place during the *primary* election, but this provision does not provide that a county chair may be in the polling place during the November election. Of course a county chair may enter the polling place to vote.

Poll Watchers

- Poll Watchers are appointed by candidates, political parties, or specific-purpose political action committees to observe at the polls
- They must present the Presiding Judge with a Certificate of Appointment
- Poll Watchers are not allowed to talk to voters
- Poll Watchers may take written notes (to include typing on a laptop NOT connected to wifi/internet) while on duty but they may NOT use recording devices (no phones, cameras, etc.)
- The Presiding Judge may give them a name tag

Electioneering

Texas Election Code Section 32.075

LAW ENFORCEMENT DUTIES AND POWERS.

- (a) The presiding judge shall preserve order and prevent breaches of the peace and violations of this code in the polling place and in the area within which electioneering and loitering are prohibited from the time the judge arrives at the polling place on election day until the judge leaves the polling place after the polls close.
- (c) In performing duties under Subsection (a), a presiding judge has the power of a district judge to enforce order and preserve the peace, including the power to issue an arrest warrant. An appeal of an order or other action of the presiding judge under this section is made in the same manner as the appeal of an order or other action of a district court in the county in which the polling place is located.
- (d) A person who is arrested at a polling place while voting or waiting to vote shall be permitted to vote, if entitled to do so, before being removed from the polling place.

Electioneering...continued

Electioneering Prohibited

 During the time a polling place is open for the conduct of voting, a person may not electioneer for or against any candidate, measure, or political party in or within 100 feet of an outside door through which a voter may enter the building or structure in which the voting polling place is located.

Examples of Electioneering

- Candidates and proponents of various viewpoints use campaigns to spread their messages to voters and urge people to vote for them or their issues.
 Some candidates hand out cards or pamphlets. Others park vehicles in parking lots with signs posted on them. Some people lobby for or against an issue.
- Carrying signs and/or wearing political logo T-shirts, buttons or other campaign-related items within the 100 foot legal boundary is considered electioneering.

Electioneering...continued

- Not allowed within 1,000 feet of the building in which a polling place is located
 - Any person using a prohibited sound amplification device, such as a megaphone or speaker system, for the purpose of making a political speech, electioneering for or against any candidate, measure or political party must be more than 1,000 feet from the polling place.

Electioneering is an offense if conducted within 100 feet of an outside door. A person commits a Class C misdemeanor if this prohibition against electioneering is violated.

- Allowed within 100 feet (not considered electioneering)
 - Voters are permitted to bring written materials into the voting place to reference, but the voter must remove them from the voting booth. Election workers should periodically check each booth and the voting location for any campaign materials left behind and dispose of them immediately.
 - Exit Polling, if not disruptive.

Firearms

• Section 46.03(a) of the Texas Penal Code generally prohibits a person from bringing a firearm onto the premises of a polling place. However, this prohibition does not apply to a peace officer, regardless of whether the police officer is on or off duty. For this and other potentially applicable exceptions, see Tex. Pen. Code § 46.15.

 The passage of House Bill 910, (84th Legislative Session, 2015), which became effective January 1, 2016, and allowed open carry of handguns, did <u>NOT</u> change the law as it pertains to guns in the polling place; thus no-one except licensed peace officers may carry handguns into the polling place.

Cell Phones/Wireless Communication Devices

- Persons (including voters) are not allowed to use wireless communications devices within 100 feet of the polling location
- Persons are not allowed to use mechanical or electronic devices to record sound or images within 100 feet of the polling location

What devices should not be used in the polling place?

- Cell phones
- Cameras
- Tablet computers
- Laptop computers
- Sound recorders
- Any other device that may communicate wirelessly, or be used to record sound or images

"Help Desk/Ushers"

- We recommend you create a "Help Desk" or assign a clerk to function as an "Usher" to control the flow of Voters
 - The Election Judge/Alternate Judge may assist the Voter with the one of the following issues without disrupting the flow of qualified voters:
 - Voter ID
 - Provisional Voter
 - Statement of Residence
 - Cancellation/Surrender of Ballot by Mail
 - Other issue(s)

Voter ID Requirements...

A voter must show one of the following forms of acceptable photo identification at the polling location before the voter may be accepted for voting, unless the voter has a reasonable impediment to obtaining one of these forms of acceptable photo identification or the voter qualifies for one of the other exemptions identified below:

- Texas Driver's License issued by the Department of Public Safety ("DPS")
- Texas Election Identification Certificate issued by DPS;
- Texas Personal Identification Card issued by DPS;
- Texas Handgun License issued by DPS;
- United States Military Identification Card containing the person's photograph;
- United States Citizenship Certificate containing the person's photograph; or
- United States Passport.

With the exception of the U.S. citizenship certificate, the identification must be current or have expired no more than 4 years before being presented for voter qualification at the polling place.

Voter Sign-In Procedure

Voter presents acceptable form of ID...

- Election Official verifies the Voter is registered
- Election Official verifies the Voters address is correct
- Election Official selects either Substantially Similar or Exact Match.
- Substantially Similar prompts the Similar Name Affidavit.
- Voter reads Affidavit & initials stating they are the same person.

- Signature is then verified by Election Official.
- Kiosk printer prints voter label to be placed on precinct combination form.
- Voter receives paper indicating what precinct and ballot is to be selected on the machine
- Voter then will cast his/her ballot.

Voter ID Requirements...continued

If a voter does not possess one of the forms of acceptable photo identification listed on the previous slide, and the voter cannot reasonably obtain such identification, the voter has the right to execute a **Reasonable Impediment Declaration** and present one of the following supporting documents:

- valid voter registration certificate;
- certified birth certificate (must be an original);
- copy of or original current utility bill;
- copy of or original bank statement;
- copy of or original government check;
- copy of or original paycheck; or
- copy of or original other government document that displays your name and an address (though an original is required if it contains a photograph).

Voter ID Requirements...continued

Exemptions: Voters with a disability may apply with the Elections Administrator for a permanent exemption to showing an acceptable form of photo identification at the polls. Voters with a religious objection to being photographed or voters who cannot present an acceptable form of photo identification due to certain natural disasters may apply for a temporary exemption to showing an acceptable form of photo identification at the polls.

Provisional Voting:

- (a) If a voter does not possess one of the seven acceptable forms of photo identification, which is not expired for more than four years, and the voter can reasonably obtain one of these forms of identification or
- (b) If a voter possesses, but did not bring to the polling place, one of the seven forms of acceptable photo identification, which is not expired for more than four years, or
- (c) If the voter does not possess one of the seven forms of acceptable photo identification, which is not expired for more than four years, could otherwise not obtain one due to a reasonable impediment, but did not bring a supporting form of identification to the polling place, the voter may cast a provisional ballot at the polls and will have six (6) calendar days after election day to present an acceptable form of photo identification, which is not expired for more than four years, in the presence of the county Elections Administrator.

Statement of Residence

- Voter with an "S" notation on the List of Registered Voters must complete a Statement of Residence
- Voter indicates that he/she has moved (even inside the precinct) must complete a Statement of Residence


Cancellation/Surrender – Ballot by Mail

- Voter list indicates that the Voter voted by mail
- Voter must complete the "Request to Cancel Application to Vote by Mail"
- Voter must surrender mail ballot
- Election Judge marks the ballot as CANCELLED
- Voter may then vote by casting a <u>Provisional</u> <u>Ballot</u> and complete the Provisional Ballot Affidavit Envelope


