International Association of Special Education (IASE)

Funding Guidelines

Objective of IASE Giving:

- To support active IASE members in their project collaborations with Volunteer Service Project Site participants in developing countries that have identified student centered projects that require resources.

Guidelines:

1. Applications for funding will be considered from current IASE members in good standing for the year preceding **and for the duration of the funded project**. Selection of funding recipients will be completed by the Volunteer Service Project Committee (VSP).
2. Applicants need to be participating in approved IASE Volunteer Service Project (VSP) site project as a volunteer or be acting on a recommendation from the VSP committee.
3. The project idea submitted for funding must be student-centered for learners with special needs. The project could be for individual children, small or large groups. These ideas might include material resources and equipment, student/travel or field trips, etc. Creative ideas are welcome.
4. A complete application form must be submitted including detailed budget information for all funds requested .Please be sure to get accurate quotes for equipment or resource costs. Please include any matching funding secured from other sources. Receipts will be required for all items purchased with approved IASE grant funds.
5. No salaries can be paid using IASE Funds.
6. Funds and/or supplies can be hand-delivered to the participating Volunteer Service Project site or purchased on site. The IASE member volunteer can purchase supplies and will be reimbursed when appropriate official bills/receipts are submitted to the VSP chair who will submit all information to the IASE treasurer.
7. All approved funding recipients are responsible for submitting all receipts and a written project report (on VSP form provided) to the VSP committee chair detailing the use/implementation of all funds within 3 months of the completion of the funded project.
8. No IASE grant funds will be provided for direct support of academic research
9. The maximum amount of any single funding request to be considered is 2500.00(USD).
10. Approved IASE grant funds must be spent within one calendar year from application approval.
