2020: The Year of Perfect Vísíon

Partners and Friends,

I know, I know. "2020. Perfect vision." Sounds cliché, right? Just stick with me. What God shared with me about this year is simply amazing!!!

First, let me welcome you to the new year and the new decade by saying, God bless you! God has wonderful things in store for you. He has new things to show you and new places He wants to take you. Everything you have experienced in your life up to this point has prepared you for this very moment in your spiritual walk. **But here's the thing:**

You're going to have to let go of your dependence on everything that you know and place your total reliance on Him. God is speaking Isaiah 42:16 to you:

I will bring [you]the blind by a way that [you] know not; *I will lead* [you] in paths that [you] have not known. *I will make darkness into light before* [you] and make uneven places into a plain. These things I have determined to do [for you]; and I will not leave [you] forsaken (AMPC, modifications mine).

God is saying, "I am going to bring you (the blind) by a way that you know not. You are not blind because you refuse to see. No, you are blind because you are going to unfamiliar places – walking unknown paths - and there are things you have not yet learned to see and recognize. But I am going to show them to you, and you will have <u>PERFECT VISION</u>.

So do not fear. I am going to lead you in paths that you have not known. Indeed, it is I Who have brought you to these paths.

So when you look and find yourself in unfamiliar places, do not fear. Do not fret. I am going to make the darkness into light before you. I am going to shine the light of My revelation on things that you do not know so that you will know what you did not know before. I have determined in My sovereignty to do this for you. I have determined to do this of My Own free will because I love you. Not because of anything that you have done or have not done. Simply because I love you and I want to do this for you. Will you receive? Will you learn of Me?

There are new places I want to take you. Let go of your dependence on what you know. The knowledge you have is good and there is a place for it. But if you place your dependence on it, you will hinder yourself from going where I am trying to take you. Place all of your reliance on Me. Do not fear, for I will not – WILL NOT – forsake you."



The Lord gave me that Word over the past couple of weeks while we (the God's Love Song Ministries Team) were on our *Light Be*! Ministry Tour in Kenya and Burundi. It goes hand in hand with the Word He gave me for 2020 just before we left:

God showed me how 2019 had been the year of "Light Be!" (i.e., "Revelation Be!") – how He had been shining His revelation light on His Word, illuminating It so His people would be able to access It better and apply It to their lives more effectively. He then showed me how 2020 would be the year that His people would let the light in and begin to walk in the revelation they receive:

They will begin to walk in the inner workings of My Word and will know how to work my Word efficiently, accurately, and precisely. They will not only receive insight, concepts, and ideas, but they will know what to do with them – how to maximize them. Their VISION will be clear, complete, and all-encompassing regarding that thing that I will give them.

They will know the end from the beginning. They will not only be carriers of the vision, but they will be communicators of the vision. As they write the vision and make it plain, others will read it and run. Their vision will come to PERFECTION: to completion, maturation, and fulfillment. <u>PERFECT VISION</u>.

There will be clarity of messages. Clarity of identity. Clarity of purpose.

There will not simply be an increase of revelation. No. There will be an increase in wisdom, knowledge, and understanding of what to do with the revelation they have received and how to bring that vision to manifestation. <u>PERFECT VISION</u>.

Amen. So, in the Name of Jesus, under the unction of the Holy Ghost, I declare unto you:

Just as the Word of God is perfect (see Psalm 19:7) – i.e., without blemish, complete, full, without spot, undefiled, and whole – your vision is without blemish, complete, full, without spot, undefiled and whole.

I decree and declare:

PERFECT VISION, IN THE NAME OF JESUS!

Vision Does Not Come Without a Message

- Proverbs 29:18a Where there is no **vision**, the people perish...
- Habakkuk 2:2 And the LORD answered me, and said, Write the **vision**, and make it plain upon tables, that he may run that readeth it.

The word "vision" in these scriptures is the Hebrew word *chazone* (khaw-zone'), which means a revelation by means of a vision, an oracle, a divine communication. The primary essence of this word is not so much the vision or dream itself as the message conveyed.¹

Therefore, it is possible to read the Word or get a Word from the Lord and still miss the message. God says, "In 2020, you're going to get the message. You're going to get the point. You're going to know what to do with what I've told you and you will reach the expected end that I have for you. Moving forward, you will operate at a new level of intentionality because you get the point."

This is a good time to take a praise break!!!

Vision Does Not Come Without Light

The word "light" in the Greek (the original language of the New Testament) is *phōs*, and it refers to the true knowledge of God and spiritual things.² In James 1:17, James calls God the Father of lights. As the Father of lights, God is the Originator of the revelation through which He reveals Himself and His ways to us. The Mirror Translation says, "...*the Father of lights, with Whom there is no distortion or even a shadow of shifting to obstruct or intercept the light…."* God is not trying to hold back even a sliver of revelation that He has for us. He wants us to know everything about Who He is, Who He is in us, and Who we are in Him. Such revelation includes what we have and what we can do in Him.

Paul received such a revelation after his life-changing encounter with Jesus on the Road to Damascus. We hear him give an account of his conversion to King Agrippa in Acts chapter 26. He explained how he saw the light (Light Be!), receiving revelation about who Jesus was, God's purpose for his life, and his God-given assignment (vv. 13-18). He then made it known to King Agrippa that he was **not disobedient to the** *heavenly vision* (v. 19).

So, we see in Paul's account to King Agrippa that the light (revelation) is directly related to the vision.

Whereas the word "vision" in the Old Testament (explained earlier in this letter) refers to the revelation conveyed through the vision, this word "vision" in the New Testament is the Greek word *optasia* (op-tas-ee'-ah), and it means "an appearing; something concretely seen."³ When we put these two definitions together, we see that it is not until we receive the revelation or the meaning behind the vision that the vision itself appears clearly.

In other words:

- The **LIGHT** (revelation) brings the spiritual enlightenment and knowledge needed to see (and understand) the vision clearly.
- Once we see the vision clearly, we can use the revelation (i.e., spiritual enlightenment) WITH INTENTIONALITY to bring the vision to pass in our lives.

Why?

- Because we will have an increase in wisdom, knowledge, and understanding of what to do with the revelation we have received. Therefore, we will know how to carry out our responsibility to bring that vision (appearing) to manifestation in our lives. We will be in the position to *on-purpose* cooperate with Holy Spirit to bring God's heavenly vision to pass in our lives.
- We will draw the vision out of the spirit realm and make it a physical reality in our natural lives.
- This is what God calls <u>PERFECT VISION</u>.

The Vision Will Come To Perfection

When something is PERFECT, it means it has reached its end. It is complete.⁴ It has done everything that it was supposed to do and yielded everything it was supposed to yield. There is nothing left undone. There is no idle portion. Every part has been fulfilled as intended. So, when God says this is the year of <u>PERFECT VISION</u>, He is saying that the vision that He has given us (both the revelation surrounding the vision and the actual vision itself) will accomplish everything in our lives that He intends for it to accomplish. There will nothing left undone.

Every good gift and every **perfect** gift (including vision) is from above, and cometh down from the Father of lights (the Originator of revelation) ...

Give God praise!!!

If you receive this Word, I would like to encourage you to sow on it. Sowing in this context is a spiritual principle where one plants their finances in the Kingdom of God to receive a harvest of what they are believing for.

When sowing a financial seed into a ministry or church, etc., you are not just making a charitable donation. Sowing a financial seed is what one does when one receives the Word that was

delivered. It is an action step that both *demonstrates your faith* in the Word that was delivered and *activates the operation* of that Word in your life. It is NOT a form of buying a blessing. NEITHER is it a selfish motive of giving to get. Rather, it is a spiritual law – the law of sowing and reaping.

Look with me at Galatians 6:7: *Be not deceived; God is not mocked: for whatsoever a man soweth, that shall he also reap* (emphasis added). Just as we cannot change the natural law of gravity, we cannot change the spiritual law of sowing and reaping. The next verse (v 8) says: For *he that soweth to his flesh shall of the flesh reap corruption; but he that soweth to the Spirit shall of the Spirit reap life everlasting.*

John 6:63 tells us that God's Word is Spirit and It is life. Therefore, the Word that you are responding to is Spirit. When you sow your financial seed, you are sowing to the Spirit, and of the Spirit, you shall reap life everlasting.

What is life everlasting?

Jesus explained in John 17:3, "And this is life eternal, that they might know Thee the only true God, and Jesus Christ, Whom Thou hast sent." So, when we sow to the Spirit, we reap life everlasting, which consists of an intimate knowledge of God – the Father and Originator of revelation Who wants to reveal every aspect of Himself to us (see James 1:17) – and His Son, Jesus, Who is the Word (John 1:1, 14) and the express Image of His Person (Heb. 1:3). Hallelujah!!! \bigcirc

As you prepare to sow your next seed (sowing outlets are listed at the end of this letter), sow it in faith as demonstration that you believe you receive a harvest of this Word in your life. Be blessed knowing that I am praying for you and speaking <u>PERFECT VISION</u> to you, in Jesus' Name.

Just remember:

As we continue to walk in God's declaration of **Light Be!** in our lives and begin to walk in the revelation of that light, we will begin to walk in the inner workings of God's Word. We will know how to operate in the Word efficiently, accurately, and precisely to bring God's <u>heavenly</u> <u>vision</u> for us to pass in our lives and to experience it in all of its **perfection** (completion, maturation, and fulfillment).

May you receive your **PERFECT VISION**, in Jesus' Name.
