We are always looking for sharp, caring volunteers, for our camp (become a camp counselor), support group meetings, or community service project; we want dedicated and enthusiastic individuals to join our team! Our volunteer program is very flexible and is designed to meet your needs and interests.

Although there are many areas of opportunity to volunteer with our organization, we are mainly in need of volunteers for our summer camp and monthly support group meetings. Volunteers are required to dedicate at least 4 hours per day, providing care to special needs children and their siblings while in our care.

The intake process for our volunteers varies, depending on the volunteer position you are interested in fulfilling, which can include but not limited to an telephone interview, face to face interview, reference check, and background check. Volunteers will be asked to fill out detailed volunteer application and attend an orientation and given a tour of the facility. During this time prospective volunteers will have the opportunity to train with an experience staff or volunteer on the policy and procedures of Trusted Parents and our volunteer program. Our dress code requires that our staff and volunteers wear clothing that are comfortable and have adequate amount of coverage and closed toe shoes (sneakers preferred).
