From the Pastor's Desk

Dear brothers and sisters,

The Church of Newark is inviting us starting this weekend to start Vines and Branches Initiative. You may ask what is that? In a nutshell, Vines and Branches is a call to take advantage of this time that we are living in our society to question where we want the parish to go and what are the things that we need in our parish to grow. We cannot continue doing the same things expecting different results. It is a time to go look for those far away who do not come anymore. We need to re-engage in a new dialog with the people. The Second Vatican Council called us to go to those in the world and talk to them without forgetting our roots and who we are. St. Jose Maria Escriva de Balaguer said that we need to bring Christ with us everywhere we go. In the parish we have been doing several things to try to let everyone in the parish (be it parishioner or not) that the Church is open, and we are here to serve them. Things like the parish BBQ, the parish Family Hike in Bear Mountain, the parish Visitation House by House, and we are going to do a 24-Hour Eucharistic Adoration on October 12 and 13, and the Mass and Procession of Our Lady of Fatima on October 12 @ 7:30 PM, and the Couples Course in Spanish of Father Larrañaga on October 17 @ 2 pm. In the Pastoral Council we have formed a committee that will meet soon to start discussing new ways, new approaches... Bishop Saporito said that we cannot just restart like nothing has happened on the contrary it is an opportunity to bring the Church to the World. I really want to see a parish that is full of Faith, that is witnessing to the world who Christ is and brings His Life and Love to the world. Also, I am still looking for volunteers so if you are interested in participating in an adoration ministry, I would like to make our Eucharistic Chapel more available, please contact me at the rectory. Remember that if you need anything, Fr. Preston and I are available here for you.


