RE: "PRAYER AND FASTING: A RIGHTFUL YEAR'S BEGINNING"

AND FASTING = January 29-31. Choose your of time of day, as 1 hour per day between 6 AM — 6 PM, adhering to Prayer and Fasting Guidelines. Obtain your doctor's advice. as/if necessary.

If there were ever a time we need to think about what will happen after our death – unless we are alive when **JESUS CHRIST** returns (I Thessalonians 4:17) - the time is <u>NOW</u> – beginning <u>70DAW</u>! The world is, now, even more wicked than before; at the same time, living a <u>GODLY/RIGHTEOUS Life</u> is more than we can handle on our own. We need <u>GOD</u> to help us and <u>HE</u> is here for us, even as <u>HE</u> said in Hebrews 13:5. "I will never leave you nor forsake you." Unless we take <u>HIM</u> at HIS Word, <u>OBEY HIM</u> and <u>KEEP HIS WORD</u> of every command, we are doomed to spend our eternity "in the lake that burns with fire and brimstone." (Revelation 21:8) <u>BUT! HOLD ON!</u> There is <u>HOPE</u> for us in <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>!! Our lives can end on a good note- if we are prepared to enter into eternal/everlasting life with <u>JESUS CHRIST</u>!!

Questions:

What does it mean to be saved? How can we become saved? How can we inherit eternal life?

Answers:

By 1) <u>Listening, 2) Reading,</u> then 3) <u>Obeying the WORD of GOD</u> (<u>The Holy Bible</u>)—in every aspect. (To <u>Obey</u> means to <u>DO</u> the <u>WILL of GOD</u>, for it is the <u>WILL of GOD</u> that "we might be saved."(I Timothy 2:3-4) We <u>DO HIS Will</u> by <u>listening</u> to the Voice of GOD through <u>HIS Word</u>.

<u>LISTENING</u> leads to READING; <u>READING</u> leads to <u>Obeying/DOING</u> <u>GOD's WORD</u>.

<u>GOD's WORD</u> contains <u>HIS Commandments for our lives</u>. The Bible says, "<u>If</u> we <u>LOVE GOD</u>, we <u>will <u>KEEP HIS COMMANDMENTS</u>." (I John 5:3)</u>

- 1) HIS Commandments of Becoming Saved contain these Steps to Salvation. (Acts 2:38): "Then Peter said unto them, [1] REPENT, [2] and BE BAPTIZED [Who?] everyone of you [How?] IN THE NAME OF JESUS CHRIST [Why?] for the remission of sins, [3] and YE SHALL RECEIVE THE GIFT OF THE HOLY GHOST. For the promise is unto you, and to your children, and to those who are afar off, even as many as the LORD our GOD shall "call. [What promise? The promise of the Holy Ghost]
- 2) **HIS COMMANDMENTS of Staying/Keeping/Remaining Saved** contain information needed for **NOT sinning**, nor even **Practicing sin** through the elements of 1) **Thinking**; 2) **Saying**; and 3) **Doing UNGODLY/UNRIGHTEOUS THINGS**!!

Explanation for * (above paragraph)

- 1) <u>Abbreviated Postings</u>. Rarely done, may include a shortened version of the Study Guide, to easily post into your Smart Device (no discussion).
- 2) <u>Bible Study Guide</u>. May include detailed information, as Introduction/Background/Explanation of Theme/Topics; Assignments (some rhetorical); Questions for your own research insertions, interactiveness, etc.; Some materials/supplies needed: Bible [for writing/marking], Bibles for easier understanding: NLT, Amplified, etc.. GOAL: To be READY FOR HEAVEN – at THIS MOMENT! through reading the **HOLY BIBLE**, then making personal application in OBEDIENCE to **GOD's WORD** by living a GODLY/RIGHTEOUS Life.

*Scriptures are from the King James Version [KJV] of the Bible. [For easier reading, install the 1) The "YouVersion Bible," app for ALL "Compare Versions;" etc.; 2) "Google" for Cross References; 3) "Google" for Bible Hub Commentaries; 3) "Google" for 'GOT Questions'].

INFORMATION:

*The number 20. Originally, 20 comes from the number 10 ["Divine Perfection"]. Twenty [20].is 10 +10 ["Divine Perfection x 2"].

One ten hundred = the exponent of 100 = 1000. 1000; one millennial = 1000. Two ten hundreds = 2×1000 x the exponent of 1000 = 2000; two millennials = 2000.

*From several writers, The number 20 can denote <u>Regeneration and a New Beginning for us</u> - only through GOD's Gift of Redemption for us.),

The number "3,"- as in "23" - according to some - is a symbol of one's New Life,

Completeness, Harmony/Solidity and Divine Wisdom in JESUS CHRIST, as we shall become through our "triple" our tripling down on satan, then "TRIPLE" our "TRIPLING UP" our time, effort, dedication, etc. in pleasing GOD, via living a GODLY/RIGHTEOUS LIFE so that we WILL BE READY TO INHERIT EVERLASTING/ETERNAL LIFE WITH JESUS CHRIST — whenever HE comes for us (whether in transition from life on earth OR "caught up" to meet HIM in the air! [I Thessalonians 4:13-17].

As the number 10 symbolizes "Divine Perfection," we can conclude that the number 2000 (20/20 + 3 - together - written) can mean "Completeness, Realness, Divine perfection," etc. for us through

- 1) The REDEMPTION of **JESUS CHRIST** through **HIS** redeeming [purchasing us from sins through **HIS BLOOD** shed on Calvary **HIS** sacrificing **HIMSELF** by sacrificing **HIS OWN LIFE** just to save us from the penalty of Sin through the **HOLY GHOST**.
- 2) Thusly, we can conclude the "<u>Divine Perfection</u>" we are seeking is through Regeneration and Resurrection in a New Life in Jesus Christ all through <u>HIS REDEMPTIVE</u>
 <u>LOVE FOR US</u> even while we were yet sinners!

RATIONALE:

If there were ever a time we needed to think about what will happen to us after our death, the time is \underline{NOW} – **BEGINNING** \underline{TODAY} ! The New Testament (and Old Testament Bible Readings for the next 365 days intend to get us ready (even the moreso than in the past) for spending

our eternity with Jesus Christ! The sub-theme for this year is relevant to **AMIREADY**

TO GO TO HEAVEN AT THIS MOMENT!

PREMISE:

Throughout the Old Testament, people were constantly disobedient to **GOD** (resulting in Ungodly and Unrighteous living that resulted in dire consequences of bondage, famine, death, etc..

The same can happen with people who live that way today. On the other hand, persons who were (and are) **OBEDIENT to GOD (living GODLY/ RIGHTEOUSLY)** had/HAVE good consequences of having their **NAMES recorded in HEAVEN – to live in HEAVEN FOR ETERNITY** (HEBREWS 11 [OUR NAMES CAN BE WRITTEN IN HEAVEN FOR ETERNAL LIFE, AS WELL.])

Everything one sees or hears in today's world reflects signs of the coming of JESUS CHRIST.

For those who are saved (depicting Godliness/Righteousness in Obedience to God's Word – and the NT – not forsaking the Holy Scriptures that state we MUST live a GODLY/RIGHTEOUS Life.

Ephesians 5:27 states: "That HE [JESUS CHRIST] might present it to HIMSELF a glorious

church, NOT having spot or wrinkle, or any such thing; but it SHOULD BE holy and without blemish") — regardless of your own personal interpretation of these words. (Even the old adage of an Ivory soap commercial many years ago that claimed it was "99 and 44% pure" will not work nor qualify one to have eternal life with JESUS CHRIST — the same applies to any person who thinks he/she will live eternally with JESUS CHRIST with less than what is stated in Ephesians 5:27**, and who also believes no one can live a HOLY life. Again, what does the Bible say? Stated in I John 5:17, "ALL UNRIGHTEOUSNESS IS SIN," summarized in Revelation21:7-8, "He that overcometh shall inherit all things;...But the fearful, and unbelieving, and the abominable, and murderers, and whoremongers, and sorcerers, and idolaters, and all liars, shall have their part in the lake which burneth with fire and brimstone: which is the second death." WE'VE GOT TO BE READY FOR HEAVEN-TODAY!! Do you really believe GOD would allow Ungodliness/Unrighteousness/Imperfectness in HIS HEAVEN?

**Other Scriptures regarding Ephesians 5:27:

<u>Holy</u> – Leviticus 19:1-2; Romans 7:12; 12:1; I Peter 1:13-16; Revelation 22:11-12 <u>Holiness</u> – Ephesians 4:24; Hebrews 12:14; I Peter 2:9-10

Holy conversation, Godliness, Righteousness, Spot, Blameless - II Peter 3:9-14

Blame, Blameless - Ephesians 1:4; I Corinthians 1:8; I Thessalonians 5:14-23

Would you agree that **GOD** would be **UNfair** to allow **any** form of **UNgodliness/**UNrighteousness enter **HIS** DOMAIN. If this were the case, then there would be NO need for Hell, Fire, and Brimstone.

BUT – hold on! There is reprieve! **When you DO sin, do these**:

#1: **CONFESS** your sins to **GOD**. [I John 1:9 states, "If we confess our sins, **H**E is faithful and just to <u>FORGIVE us of our sins</u>, and to cleanse us from <u>ALL</u> <u>UNRIGHTEOUSNESS</u>."

#2: REPENT of your sins. ["TURN around 180 degrees from your sin.]

- a) Again, read I John 1:9.
- b) Re-read <u>Acts 2:38</u> [page 1]
- c) Micah 7:18-19: "Who is GOD like unto thee, that pardoneth iniquity, and passeth by the transgression of the remnant of HIS heritage? Ho retaineth not HIS anger for ever, because HE delighteth in mercy. HE will turn again, HE will have compassion upon us: HE will subdue our iniquities; and thou wilt cast all their sins into the depths of the sea."
- d) <u>Hebrews 12:1</u>: "Wherefore seeing we also are compassed about with so great a cloud of witnesses, let us lay aside every weight, and the sin whichdoth so easily beset us, and let us run with patience the race that is set before us..."[Also, read verse 2]
- e) <u>II Peter 3:9</u>: "The <u>LORD</u> is not slack concerning <u>HIS</u> promise, as some men count darkness; but it is longsuffering to us-ward, not willing that any should perish, but that all should come to repentance."
- f) <u>Hebrews 8:12</u>: "For <u>l</u> will be merciful to their unrighteousness, and their sins will <u>l</u> remember no more."
- g) John 2:1-2: "My little children, these things write Lunto you, that And HE is the propitiation for our sins, that YE SIN NOT. And IF ANY MAN SIN, WE HAVE AN ADVOCATE WITH THE FATHER, JESUS CHRIST, THE RIGHTEOUS: AND HE IS THE PROPITIATION FOR OUR SINS: AND NOT FOR OUR SINS ONLY, BUT ALSO FOR THE SINS OF THE WHOLE WORLD."

 The New Living Bible translates these verses thusly: "My little children, Lam writing to you so that you WILL NOT SIN, BUT if anyone does sin, we have an advocate who pleads our case before the Father. HE is JESUS CHRIST the One who Is TRULY RIGHTEOUS."

h) Psalm 103:8-12: "The LORD is merciful and gracious, slow to anger, and plenteous in mercy. HE will not chide: neither will HE keep HIS anger for ever. HE hath not dealt with us after our sins; nor rewarded us according to our iniquities. For as the heaven is high above the earth, so great is HIS mercy toward the that fear Him. As far as the east is from the west, so far hath HE removed our transgressions from us."] NOW, read ALL of Psalm 103, for it will surely and truly BLESS your Soul!!]

#3: DO NOT REVERT TO COMMITTING THIS SIN, AND ESPECIALLY NOT PRACTICING THIS, NOR ANY SIN [habitually

SAYING wrong things, THINKING wrongly, or DOING wrongly] your former(habit-formingl sin(s) nor LIVING your former Ungodly/Unrighteous lifestyle(s), for **JESUS** has forgiven you of your sins.. Only you can recall it to begin **PRACTICING** [repeating the "thing"] that **GOD** has forgiven you of. If you do **Practice Sin** [repeat sin], you are on very dangerous ground.

Remember:

- 1) **GOD LOVES YOU**, for John 3:16 states, "For **GOD** so loved the WORLD, that **HE** gave **HIS** only **begotten Son**, that whosoever <u>BELIEVETH* ON HIM SHOULD NOT PERISH</u>, but HAVE EVERLASTING LIFE." Remember: Hell was not designed for you; it was actually designed and prepared for the devil and his angels. People have a choice of where they want to spend Eternity; God will never force anyone to go to Heaven or Hell.
- 2)*<u>BELIEVETH on HIM</u> -in John 3:16- means to <u>THINK, SAY</u>, <u>DO</u> what <u>HE</u> commands us-to <u>DO</u>, <u>SAY</u>, <u>THINK</u> what is <u>in</u> **HIS WORD**. <u>HIS WORD</u> is the <u>HOLY BIBLE</u> HIS <u>HOLY BIBLE</u> contains what <u>HE</u> commands/demands of us in full OBEDIENCE to HIM.
- 3)* $\underline{\textbf{JESUS}}$ [in John 14:15, 23, 24] said, " $\underline{\textbf{IF}}$ you love me, keep my commandments. ... $\underline{\textbf{IF}}$

a man love me, he will keep my WORDS: and MY Father will love him, and we will come unto him, and make our abode with him. He that loveth me nor keepeth not my sayings: and the Word which you hear is not mine, but the FATHER'S which sent me." What are some of these WORDS/COMMANDMENTS referenced for us by JESUS CHRIST? Some are known as "The Ten Commandments," found in Exodus 20:1-17, and are summarized in Matthew 22:39, Mark 10:19 and Romans 13:9.
