Inner Healing

Why is inner healing/deliverance important

- If you are wounded and living with open wounds it will give the enemy an opening with which to use against you.
- It will stunt your growth and keep you from experiencing the fullness of God in this life – mind renewal will not be successful.

Preparing to Face the Giants - Internal Wounds

Identifying emotional wounds

- Little or no tolerance/patience
- Hard to forgive
- Hard to feel loved
- Lashing out
- Self-hatred
- Escapism
- Retaliation urges
- Irresponsible behavior
- Irrational expectations of others
- Perfectionism
- Feelings of hopelessness
- Drivenness
- Hostility towards God, self, and others

Freedom from the Past

Our pain is rarely rooted in the present. Past experiences even back to childhood experiences can mess up adult promises – or the way we view God's promises to us now as adults.

- Many times childhood problems become adult issues
- But in God's process, He will replace hurt for healing, beauty for ashes and give us GRACE to live this life to the fullest.
- Why does the process take so long? It takes time to break old patterns and create new ones that are spiritually sound and beneficial
- The healing process will bring about transformation and change. Sometimes we want the outcome to happen without going through the process. But the process leads to the outcome – growth, transformation and freedom in Christ.
