## **Stop Playing Church**

In the last month, we have seen 6 new church members join us in our mission of Empowering the church to share the gospel, equipping believers to grow in their faith, and encouraging families to minister to their children. Praise God! We hope to see more people in our community take their faith seriously and get connected to a local church.

Have you ever heard of the term "Playing Church", it's very common inside the church walls and even outside the church walls. Let's talk about both:

Inside the church walls:

Church members may be able to share a few Bible stories with you, but their faith is very shallow. In fact, if they didn't post about it on social media, we wouldn't know about it by the way they interact with others in the community. Often these people are great at gossip, they are at church every week that is humanly possible and they may not have a great reputation even among other church members. Anytime I am sharing about what God is doing at Gila Valley I tell people that,

#### We are not a perfect church, but we worship a perfect God

The church is full of sinful people because these people know how much they need Jesus. As you're reading this, maybe you're thinking of someone. First, I apologize if you have experienced a negative conversation or been hurt by someone in our church. That's not okay. Second, if you are a Christian then you would know that He who is without sin should throw the first stone. (Only Jesus was able to condemn, and he didn't He showed mercy.) Third, if you're an unbeliever, I want you to know that Jesus is perfect, and died for us because our sin separates us from a perfect God. Now as Christians we are seen as perfect by God through Jesus. That is called grace. Would you consider learning more about what a Christian looks like, and forgive those of us who didn't live out what we claim to believe? Maybe they were "playing church".

Outside the church walls:

Only in America is it popular to go to church somewhere. In fact, when those "playing church" outside of the church walls are asked, "Where do you go to church?" They name a church that they used to be a member of but no longer attend. They name a church that they went to when they were 12, or maybe even during a special service or funeral for a friend. ## How to Grill the Best Burgers

#### **Ingredients**

- 2 pounds 80/20 ground beef, cold
- 4 cloves minced garlic
- 2 tablespoons minced onion
- 1 tablespoon Worcestershire sauce
- 1 3/4 teaspoons freshly ground pepper
- 1 1/2 teaspoons salt
- 6 hamburger buns

Butter for buns

Make the burger mix: Put the cold ground beef in mixing bowl. Sprinkle the other ingredients evenly over top. Fold the meat over a few times to get everything mixed. This entire process should only take about 30 to 45 seconds. Don't over handle the meat.

Shape the burger patties: Rather than forming the patties in your hand, form them on a tray. This makes it easier to shape the patties without over-handling or warming the meat. I like to use a cookie sheet lined with parchment paper, but any tray or platter will do. On the tray, divide the meat into 6 equal parts (about 5 1/4 ounces each). Gently form each portion into a patty that is 4-inches across with 1-inch sides and a shallow depression in the middle. You want the outer 1/2 inch of the patty to be slightly taller than the inside. This keeps the patty from shrinking too much and from puffing up in the center during grilling. Cover the patties with plastic wrap and transfer to the fridge while you heat up your grill and butter your buns.

Heat the grill: Heat a gas or charcoal grill to 450 to 500°F, or hot enough that you can only hold your hand above the grill grates for about 1 second. Butter the insides of all the buns and set them near the grill.

Grill the burgers: Place patties on the grill over direct heat. Cook to your desired doneness: For rare burgers, cook for 4 minutes total (125°F), For medium-rare burgers, cook for 5 minutes total (135°F), For medium burgers, cook for 6 to 7 minutes total (145°F), For well-done burgers, cook for 8 to 9 minutes total (160°F). Flip the burgers at least once during cooking, or as often as you wish. Do not press down on the patties at any time.

Add the cheese and toast the buns: When you have about 1 minute left on the cooking time, add the cheese to the burgers and the buttered buns to the grill over indirect heat. Rest the burgers: Remove burgers and buns from grill and transfer to a clean platter. Let the burgers rest for 1 minute before serving.
