Romans 3:23-26

1. We all have a sin problem, it started back in Genesis 3. This is something we need to grasp to be able to fully understand what the atonement truly means. Justification-The act of being declared righteous before God not by our own doing

Grace- a gift from God that we do not deserve that we have not done anything to get. It is Gods goodness towards those that deserve punishment.

Propitiation- the act of Jesus taking on the wrath of God for our sins so we can be justified in His holy presence

3.Through the blood of Jesus and him alone vs24 Hebrews 9:11-14

4.Jesus died a death we could not die to atone for our sins which we could not take care of on our own, so we are able to come before the throne of God.

Day 2

Hebrews 10:11-14

1.That only Jesus can take away the sins of man and it was done one time for all time and that through that sacrifice he is now sitting at the right hand of God and he perfected those who trust in him for all time.

2. Once. In the Old Testament, they had to sacrifice year after year to atone for their sins.

1st John 1:5-2:6

2. Making us right before God so we can come before him. By propitiation by Jesus Christ dying the death we could not die so we can come before the Father.

3. It is through Christ that we can come to the Father.

Day 5

1st Peter 2:24-25

1. No, it is a gift from God.
2. Nope, we stray like sheep.
3. By Jesus dying on the cross
