As the Lord God Almighty is the only authority, who has given me all power over nations to rule, as in Is. 41:1-4; Rom. 13:1-7; II Cor. 10:1-8,12,13,18 & Rev. 2:26,27, to execute upon "kings", the judgment written, as in Ps. 149:1-9; Is. 34:8 & Rev. 19:1-21!
