1st/2nd: I hope everyone enjoyed their long weekend. This week we will continue working on properties of matter in second grade and movement and sound in first grade. We will be working on two-digit addition in math and telling time. We will continue working on blends in phonics in first grade and vowel combinations and digraphs in second grade. We will keep the same spelling words as last week and will test over those on Friday. **AR tests are due this Friday.** Please, be practicing your spelling bee words and your math facts each night. 3rd/4th: Now that we are back from our extra-long holiday weekend, our class will pick up where we left off. In spelling this week, it is my plan to test over last week's words for those who need it and move on to this week's words. Please be practicing the spelling bee words with your students nightly. In math, the students will continue to work on mastering their multiplication facts as well as daily lessons. Fourth grade has been given their graded math assignments back for corrections with the option of getting half credit back for those points missed. Both grades will continue to review chapter 11 in science. Fourth grade will have a science test on Wednesday while third grade will test on Thursday. Both grades will also have a test over their week 13 Missouri Studies Weekly. Study guides for these test have already been completed, graded, and returned to your students. - **Mrs. Cooper**

5th/6th: It's good to be back! Students will be catching up on some assignments from last week, so we will be busy! Both grades are getting 10 Spelling Bee words a week to study along with their regular spelling words. The students that spell the most Spelling Bee words correctly over the next 8 weeks will get to participate in the Spelling Bee at Clinton on May 2nd. In Science, 5th grade will finish a unit on simple machines and will be getting ready to test next week. 6th grade will have a test over Ch. 2 this Friday. In Reading, students will continue working in their Buckledown and C.A.R.S. workbooks. Our class will also begin a new Literature Circle Unit next week. In Social Studies, 5th grade will finish Ch. 3 over the causes of the Civil War and 6th grade will start a unit over Ancient Greece. **7/8 Comm.
