May 21, 2021—Steve Morse, "Getting Ready for the 1950 Census: Searching with and without a Name Index"

The 1950 Census will be released next year. But there won't be an index until later.

Before the indices are compiled, there will still be ways to access the information. Initially, the only way to access a name in the census will be by location. Stephen Morse will show us how this works.

Morse is well known as the designer and compiler of the "One Step Website: A Potpourri of Genealogical Search Tools" which has evolved over more than 20 years to include a wide range of tools and aids for accessing genealogical information.

The census is organized by Enumeration Districts, so in order to find a person, you need to start with the Enumeration District. In addition to locating a person without the index, knowing how Enumeration Districts work helps to locate persons whose name was transcribed incorrectly, either in the original census, or in later indices. All information in census microfilms has been arranged by Enumeration District since 1880, so this information is useful for earlier censuses as well.
