1. Overview

By using and paying for services from iTeach...iTutor LLC, you agree to the terms and conditions set forth below (Terms). For the purposes of this agreement, "you" refers to the parent/guardian who is responsible for the minor in which the services are provided for; and the term "we" refers to iTeach...iTutor LLC. A violation of these terms may lead to the termination of your contract.

iTeach...iTutor LLC reserves the right to makes changes to these Terms at **any** time. Any modifications will be effective **immediately** and constitutes your agreement to such modifications.

2. Services

The services provided by iTeach...iTutor LLC includes one-on-one tutoring, group tutoring, and online tutoring. The window of availability for these services are Monday through Thursday from 2:30pm to 8pm, Fridays from 2:30pm to 7pm, and Sundays, at your discretion, for an extra \$10 per hour added to the service price from 9am to 12pm.

iTeach...iTutor LLC provides services during spring break (Spring Academy), winter break (Winter Academy), and summer break (Summer Academy) Monday thru Thursday between the hours of 9am and 6pm.

Note: the academy sessions are a separate entity from the services provided during the academic school year. Enrollment in the academy programs will allow for a weekly flat rate of \$175.

iTeach...iTutor LLC **does not** provide services on New Year's Day, Martin Luther King, Jr. Day, Presidents Day, Memorial Day, Independence Day, Labor Day, Veteran's Day, Thanksgiving Day, and Christmas Day. For holidays that fall on a Monday or Friday, Saturday services will be unavailable.

3. Registration



Prior to your child receiving services from iTeach...iTutor LLC, you **must** complete the registration form and pay any applicable fees. The registration fee for all services provided by iTeach...iTutor LLC is \$35.

By paying the registration fee, you agree to a contract stating you will enroll your child into our program for a designated length of time. Under **no** circumstances will refunds be given; therefore, if your child does not stay in the program for the entire length of your contract, a refund will **not** be issued.

You agree to provide true and accurate information when completing the registration form. If for any reason we believe the information provided is untrue or inaccurate, we reserve the right to terminate and refuse any and all services.

7. Payment and Billing

NO Checks or Money Order will be accepted.

8. Notification of Services

iTeach...iTutor LLC reserves the right to notify you of scheduled session reminders, session updates, along with any and all information regarding your child and/or changes to services.

You will receive a text notification an hour prior to your scheduled session time.

9. Records/Privacy Policy

Unless iTeach...iTutor LLC receives your written consent, information regarding your child will not be released. All records regarding children, families and our staff are confidential.

10. Media

iTeach...iTutor LLC reserves the right to photograph and record sessions and activities for media purposes. Please see the media release form in the appendix section for more information.



11.Termination

Both parties, you and iTeach...iTutor, will provide the other with a written notice two weeks in advance prior to terminating services. Services terminated will result in you paying full price for the two weeks.

12.Late Pickup

If your child is not picked up at their designated time, this will result in you paying a \$5 late fee plus an additional \$2 charge for every five minutes thereafter in which you are late.

13. Attorney's Fees

In the event that there is any controversy, claim, or violation arising out of this Agreement, or to the interpretation, breach, or enforcement thereof, any action or proceeding is commenced to enforce the provisions of this Agreement, then the prevailing party shall be entitled to a reasonable attorney fee, costs, and expenses.

What is the influenza (flu) virus?

Influenza ("the flu") is caused by a virus which infects the nose, throat, and lungs. According to the US Center for Disease Control and Prevention (CDC), the flu is more dangerous than the common cold for children. Unlike the common cold, the flu can cause severe illness and life threatening complications in many people. Children under 5 who have the flu commonly need medical care. Severe flu complications are most common in children younger than 2 years old. Flu season can begin as early as October and last as late as May.



How can I tell if my child has a cold, or the flu?

Most people with the flu feel tired and have fever, headache, dry cough, sore throat, runny or stuffy nose, and sore muscles. Some people, especially children, may also have stomach problems and diarrhea. Because the flu and colds have similar symptoms, it can be difficult to tell the difference between them based on symptoms alone. In general, the flu is worse than the common cold, and symptoms such as fever, body aches, extreme tiredness, and dry cough are more common and intense. People with colds are more likely to have a runny or stuffy nose. Colds generally do not result in serious health problems, such as pneumonia, bacterial infections, or hospitalizations.

What should I do if my child gets sick?

Consult your doctor and make sure your child gets plenty of rest and drinks a lot of fluids. Never give aspirin or medicine that has aspirin in it to children or teenagers who may have the flu.

CALL OR TAKE YOUR CHILD TO A DOCTOR RIGHT AWAY IF YOUR CHILD:

- Has a high fever or fever that lasts a long time
 - Has trouble breathing or breathes fast
- · Has skin that looks blue
- Is not drinking enough
- Seems confused, will not wake up, does not want to be held, or has seizures (uncontrolled shaking)
- Gets better but then worse again
- Has other conditions (like heart or lung disease, diabetes) that get worse



How can I protect my child from the flu?

A flu vaccine is the best way to protect against the flu. Because the flu virus changes year to year, annual vaccination against the flu is recommended. The CDC recommends that all children from the ages of 6 months up to their 19th birthday receive a flu vaccine every fall or winter (children receiving a vaccine for the first time require two doses). You also can protect your child by receiving a flu vaccine yourself.

What can I do to prevent the spread of germs?

The main way that the flu spreads is in respiratory droplets from coughing and sneezing. This can happen when droplets from a cough or sneeze of an infected person are propelled through the air and infect someone nearby. Though much less frequent, the flu may also spread through indirect contact with contaminated hands and articles soiled with nose and throat secretions. To prevent the spread of germs:

- Wash hands often with soap and water.
- Cover mouth/nose during coughs and sneezes. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands.
- Limit contact with people who show signs of illness.
- Keep hands away from the face. Germs are often spread when a person touches something that is contaminated with germs and then touches his or her eyes, nose, or mouth.



When should my child stay home from child care?

A person may be contagious and able to spread the virus from 1 day before showing symptoms to up to 5 days after getting sick. The time frame could be longer in children and in people who don't fight disease well (people with weakened immune systems). When sick, your child should stay at home to rest and to avoid giving the flu to other children and should not return to child care or other group setting until his or her temperature has been normal and has been sign and symptom free for a period of 24 hours.
