Graduation requirements

- 22 total credits including:
- 4 credits English
- 4 credits Math (Algebra1, Geometry, Algebra2, and one additional math or math related)
- 3 credits Science (Biology and either Chemistry, Physics, Anatomy, or Horticulture, and one additional science)
- 3 credits Social Studies (US History, Economics, Government, World History)
- 2 credits World Language (same language A SECOND FINE ARTS CREDIT can replace one of these credits)
- 1 credit Fine, performing, or vocational art
- 0.5 credits Gym (or 4 years of marching band)/0.5 credits Health

And:

40 hours of community service, and reflection paper

Please note: If you passed Algebra or Spanish in Middle School – those will count toward your total!

There are trade-outs that can potentially be made in every category except English

What you CAN do, and what you want to do AFTER high school need to match though
