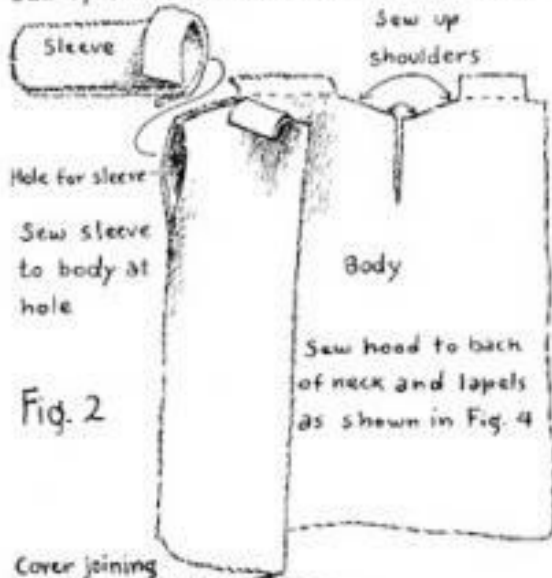

Sew up sleeves and turn back 6 inches for fringe



Sleeve

Sew up shoulders

Hole for sleeve

Sew sleeve to body at hole

Body

Sew hood to back of neck and lapels as shown in Fig. 4

Tassel ends may be cut square, fringed, or forked.

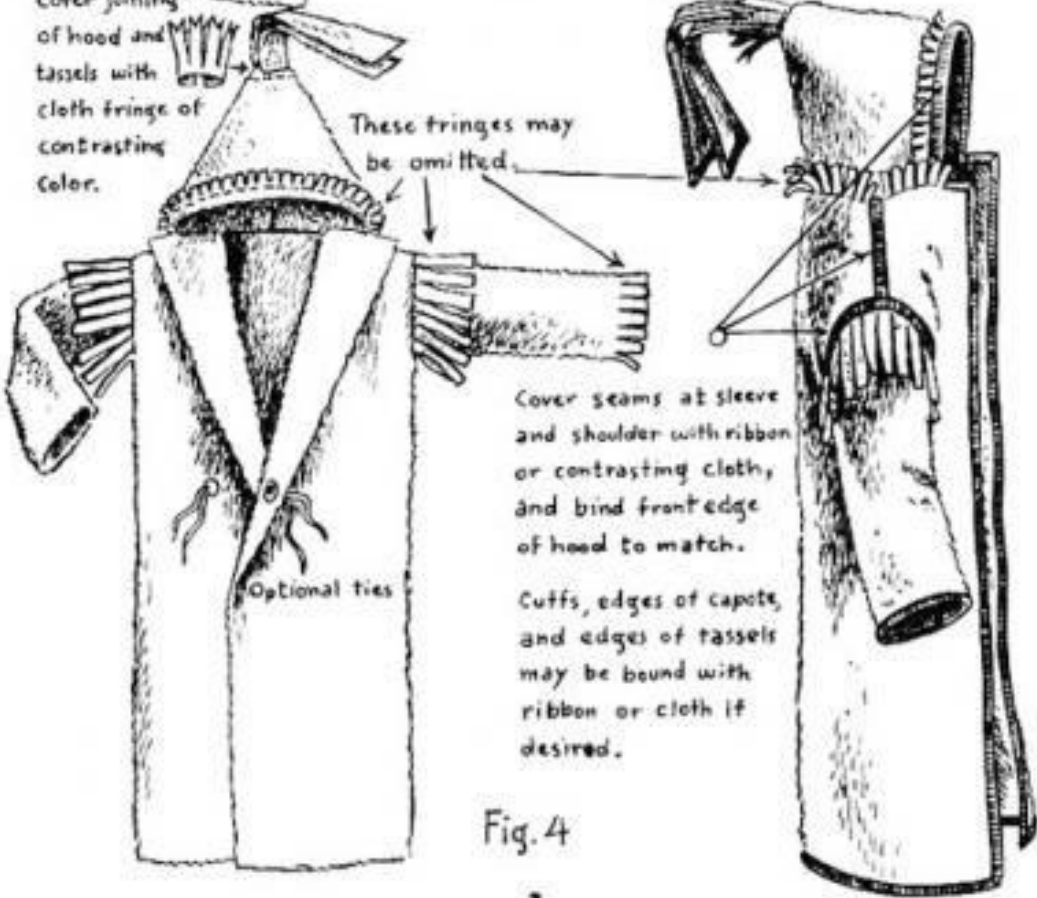
Sew one tassel to each side of hood point.

Sew up back of hood

Turn this flap back, over front of hood and sew down.

Cover joining of hood and tassels with cloth fringe of contrasting color.

These fringes may be omitted.



Cover seams at sleeve and shoulder with ribbon or contrasting cloth, and bind front edge of hood to match.

Cuffs, edges of capote, and edges of tassels may be bound with ribbon or cloth if desired.
