Reflections on the 21st Sunday in Ordinary Time ...From Deacon Jim

A relationship with Christ, lived in love, gains entry through the *narrow gate*...

Most of you likely know of a public figure, a music or TV or movie star, or a political candidate that most intrigues and fascinates you. Even if you know all about them, if you approached them in a restaurant, they would say, "Who are you?" You might be interested in the celebrity but would have no relationship with them. You would not be friends

Not so with Jesus. You know him: head knowledge. You know him in your heart. With him you have a personal relationship. He calls you "friend". You know him as Lord and Savior. You trust that when you die, you will meet him face-to-face.

Do you deserve that relationship? Do any of us? The answer is "no" but he loves us unconditionally as we love him in return. In John's Gospel, Christ says, "I am the gate. Whoever enters through me will be saved." In this weekend's Gospel from Luke, Jesus says to "enter through the narrow gate." May we never stray far from that Gate—from a relationship with one celebrity who calls us "friend"—Christ.

Heaven and Hell

As we see in this Sunday's Gospel, Jesus is serious, even though we, today, may not be about our "last end"--our Eternity...Heaven = Celestial eternal life with God and saints and others!, Or...

Hell= those who consciously refuse God Himself or His Ways =by choices or way of life choices

Essence of hell = separation from God and loved ones forever (CCC#)

Gospel stories -Jesus mentions it many times in sermon on Mt!- See Wedding Feast these all corroborate afterlife justice

In an era today of unbelief and doubt it is difficult to believe in Hell, after all, we are taught terms and emotions like: nice, tolerance, all-inclusiveness --and while these are good, they are like "loaded dice" or "stacked cards"= ways to select and prejudice results and "make a new social order" according to progressivists lines. In terms of the afterlife, Heaven and Hell we need to be aware of this...

Universalism = is a error which says that all are going to Heaven and Jesus sacrificial bloody death does not count /mean anything, many have made this mistake ...This is like saying in the Olympics, football practice and school academics, "all are in" in spite of standards

Another way to understand Judgment/Heaven/ Hell= We have an Ultimate Test/Exam: we work, study, perform best under pressure (Olympics), exams (school), (Another way to understand = metaphysics= our souls are like sponges= we absorb and conform like a sponge to outside elements (images / other's behaviors) and inside ones (choices and thoughts) and retain these---are we clean or toxic, dirty or chaste at Final Exam? **The ABC's of Eternal Life**= A=Accept God as Savior and His Ways! B=Become like Him, Christ, and Love God and neighbor with all your soul! C= Ongoing Conversion and Confession! + Peace and Blessings - Father Jack Lombardi
