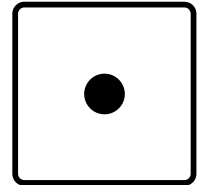


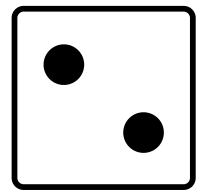

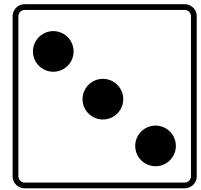
Draw the top section of the  
Christmas Tree



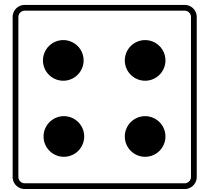
Draw the middle section of  
the Christmas Tree



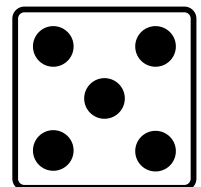
Draw the bottom section of  
the Christmas Tree



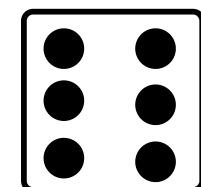
Draw the trunk of the

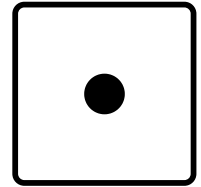

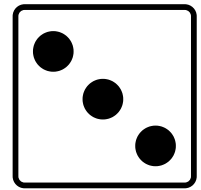

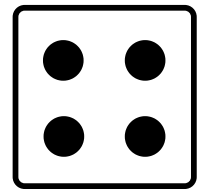

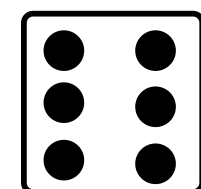

# Don't Burn the Christmas Tree

## DIRECTIONS

---

### Materials:

- Dice
- Paper or dry erase board
- Pencils, crayons, markers, dry erase markers

### Directions:

- Roll a dice and draw the portion of the picture listed in the Key
- When decorating (#5) you can only draw on one section of the tree each turn, you have to roll a 5 three times in the younger kids version and four times in the older kids version (3 sections & star).

### Easier and Harder Options:

- To make the older kids version even more challenging, add the rule that the trunk (#4) must be drawn first to start the tree. You can continue to increase the challenge by requiring the tree to be drawn from the bottom up.
- To make this game easier, you can draw the outline of the tree and have your child color in each section.
- Another option to change the game is to have drawn pieces that must be cut out and glued together.
