Plans for our Second Premium Single Malt Night are in the process of being finalized. The cost of the evening will be \$125/person. The dinner will be similar to the one we enjoyed last year. On hand will be three premium single malts, which will average between \$200-250. A special treat and the central reasons for the price increase include a recent contact I had with Marc Laverdiere wherein he has provided me access to Macallan 25 year old (see below). Additionally, Paul Charbonneau has gracefully offered to bring along a choice of cigar for each person in attendance. Due to the costs involved in the purchase of the single malt bottles I will require a financial commitment of a minimum 24 people. After that, a wait list will be developed. Additional people will be permitted to attend but only in increments of 24. As I mentioned before this is simply to take best financial advantage of sharing the cost of each bottle.

To allow for no single malt drinkers and partners to attend there will be a non-drinking price which will cover the cost of the dinner. Additionally, if there is enough interest I may be willing to bring along personally requested bottles of wine that are placed on my permit.

Here's the scoop: only 30 bottles of The Macallan 25 are available for Ontario in 2009 at \$649.95 each, under a private order from Maxxium Canada, air shipped from Scotland in 2 weeks. The bottles will never hit the shelves of the LCBO as the LCBO is not ordering any. This is a private order to ensure that our best customers get their fair share of a very restricted allocation from Scotland. Regards... and cheers! Marc

BREAD AND BUTTER PUDDING WITH WHISKY SAUCE

8 slices white bread, crust trimmed, buttered
3/4 cup (175 ml) sultana raisins, or mixed dried fruit
1 1/2 tsp (7 ml) grated nutmeg
3/4 cup (175 ml) white sugar
2 eggs, lightly beaten
1 1/4 cups (300 ml) 18% table cream
1 cups (500 ml) milk
1 tsp (5 ml) vanilla
Brown sugar for sprinkling
Preheat oven to 350. Place four slices of bread, buttered

side down in 8 inch square pan. Sprinkle with sultanas, half the nutmeg and 1 Tbsp white sugar. Cover with remaining bread, buttered side down, and sprinkle with remaining nutmeg and 1 Tbsp sugar. Combine eggs, cream, milk vanilla and remaining sugar. Pour over bread and sprinkle brown sugar on top. Bake 1 hour or until all liquid has been absorbed and pudding is risen and brown.

Whisky Sauce:

10 Tbsp (150 ml) butter 1/2 cup sugar

1 egg

3 Tbsp (50 ml) whisky

Just before serving, make sauce by melting butter in heavy saucepan over med-low heat. Add sugar and stir to

dissolve. Remove from heat to cool slightly. Beat egg and whisky together in separate bowl. Add slowly to warm butter mixture, whisking vigorously. Serve pudding hot in small bowl with a few spoonfuls of whisky sauce poured on top. Garnish with apple slices if desired.

Reservation policy

- Our contract with the Officer's Mess Kitchen requires that we provide seven (7) business days notice for them to guarantee accommodation for our requested numbers. Each month an invitation will be sent out to all members of the Society in the first week of the respective month in which the dinner will be held. To accommodate the Kitchen's needs and meet our contractual obligation with them; our members are requested to respond to the emailed invitation seven (7) business days prior to the respective dinner to guarantee a seat at the dinner. After that members will be placed on a waitlist.

- For these individuals the process will be as follows, using the November 24th dinner date as an example:

Dinner invitations will be sent out Saturday November 1st, 2008. Please respond to me (rdifazio@cogeco.ca). I will then acknowledge that you have a seat. Please understand that if you do not receive a response you are not guaranteed a seat at the respective dinner. In such circumstances (e.g., computer glitches) please e-mail me again or call me at (613-634-0397).
Accommodation at the dinner will be guaranteed for a member who responds by Wednesday November 12th, 2008 midnight.

Cancellation policy

- Using the same example as above, anyone who cancels anytime prior to Wednesday November 12th, 2008 midnight will be removed from the list.

- Anyone cancelling between Wednesday November 12th, 2008 midnight and Monday November 24th, 2008 will be expected to pay for the cost of the dinner and scotch (\$50). It is the responsibility of the member who cancels their reservation to find a replacement. If I can substitute an individual from the wait-list, then the member will not be asked to pay for their cancellation.

- Anyone who fails to attend the November 24th, 2008 dinner without having cancelled and been successfully replaced will be expected to pay the full cost (\$50). The member will be responsible for their guest's cancellation.

- If a member asks to be included at the dinner between Wednesday November 12th, 2008 midnight and Monday November 24th, 2008, your name will be placed on a wait-list and be accommodated on a first-come first-serve basis.
