The NEW and TRUE Temple.

In Jesus' time the Temple in Jerusalem had become a cattle mart, a huge abattoir and a bureau of change. This was so because those who came from afar did not bring their own animals for sacrifice but had to buy them at the Temple. Also non-Jews were excluded from the Temple. The dream of the prophets of ALL Nations coming to the Temple was blocked by legislation. Because of all the activity it was everything except a place of prayer. The action of Jesus was interpreted by the religious leaders as a claim to be the Messiah. They remembered the prophetic texts which promised that the Messiah would come and take possession of the Temple. So – they wanted a sign. Jesus answered; 'Destroy this sanctuary and in three days I will raise it up.' In his eyes the sanctuary was already destroyed because it had lost its purpose.
