

Messiah Messenger A message from the Pastor

Dear Friends in Christ,

If you've dared to venture out in these bitterly cold winter evenings, especially when it's been clear, you've probably been dazzled by the countless stars that have filled the night sky. But as you've looked heavenward, did you happen to pause and consider what the stars can teach us about our Lord Jesus? As a way of equipping you for your next star sightings, we would like to suggest a few things the stars can point out to us.

First of all...<u>STARS ARE A SYMBOL OF HOPE</u>. Stars by their very nature add a bit of brightness to an expanse of sky that would otherwise be an utterly black canvas. Like the effect of a tiny candle flickering in a dark room, stars break through the blackness of the night and add a splendor to our surroundings that can dispel feelings of fear and uncertainty. As these tiny celestial lights move across the sky and slowly disappear in the blush of dawn's first light, we also are reminded that our journey through the night is coming to an end, and that our hope for a bright, new tomorrow is near!

Our Lord Jesus can be described in a similar fashion. In fact, Jesus described Himself as the "Light of the world." A "Light" that the darkness cannot overcome. Perhaps this image of our Lord as "Light" is what inspired hymn writer John Henry Hopkins to compose the memorable words we love to sing... "Oh, star of wonder, star of night, star with royal beauty bright; westward leading, still proceeding, guide us to thy perfect light." It's true...Jesus is the "perfect Light" we can look to as we experience life in a world that often seems dark and dreary.

But there's another truth about our Lord that we can attribute to stars. <u>STARS ARE RELIABLE GUIDES</u>. For generations, people have looked to the stars as a way of orienting themselves in the world. The famous navigator Christopher Columbus would have been totally lost if he didn't know how to rely on the North Star to direct his ships across the vast expanse of the Atlantic Ocean.

The magi whose journey we read of in Matthew's Gospel also knew how important it was to rely on the stars. For them, those heavenly lights spoke of a Great Guide who would be born a King among kings!

As we transition beyond the season of Christmas, we are about to embark on a spiritual journey called the season of Epiphany that reintroduces us to this Great Guide. The stories we will hear in this season of worship will highlight many of the ways our Lord Jesus begins to make Himself known as God's Son and the remarkable impact He will have on this world will be like "Light" piercing through the night. Indeed, there is no One better to lead us through our experiences of darkness and toward the light than our Lord Jesus!

Yes, there is much the stars can tell us about our Lord, but one more truth needs to be declared. **STARS ARE ENDURING**. One of the reasons stars are so reliable as navigational guides is that they remain virtually unchanging. They have a long history of shining from generation to generation. Seasons come and go. Life's challenges come and go. But the guiding light of the stars is always there! This is exactly who our Lord Jesus proclaimed Himself to be for us. The Letter to the Hebrews reminds us of this reality with these memorable words: "Jesus Christ is the same yesterday and today and forever." (Hebrews 13:8). He is eternal – everlasting – the beginning and the end of all things!

The stars offer many helpful insights about our Lord Jesus. But the most meaningful connection may be this: MEED FOR GOD'S LIGHT IN OUR LIVES! As we begin this new year with all of its unknowns, may those tiny, heavenly lights that shimmer and shine in our nighttime sky cause us to look continually to our Lord Jesus...the PERFECT LIGHT...who longs to show us the way to live each and every day in His Light!

Karyn made a motion to accept the agenda as written. Seconded by Keith and passed unanimously.

Staff reports:

Resolution Regarding Resumption of In-Person Worship

The Council of Messiah Lutheran Church hereby resolves that it will resume in-person worship as of September 27, 2020.

Consistent with our calling to love and care for one another and for the health of our neighbors, any person attending in-person worship (including weddings and funerals) or other church activities must:

- (1) sign-in providing their name and phone number,
- (2) wear a mask at all times,,
- (3) maintain social distancing.

Those who are ill, have tested positive for COVID-19, or who are in vulnerable populations should refrain from attending in-person worship or other church activities.

Persons exposed to COVID-19, or who have previously tested positive for COVID-19, must refrain from attending in-person worship or other church activities until at least 14 days after they have tested negative for the presence of the virus.

Persons who choose to attend in-person worship or other church activities agree to inform the church promptly if they learn they have tested positive for COVID-19 or have been exposed to COVID-19.

Notice of COVID-19 exposure should be made by calling Larry Hosaluk (Pastor or other person) at 218-242-7728 and should inform us of the relevant date(s) of in-person church attendance.

The church will then make appropriate **anonymous** notifications to others who may have been in attendance on the same date, so they may take appropriate steps to protect their health and safety. (The church could assist public health authorities with lists of contacts to help with tracing and will assist them in any efforts to undertake contact tracing if requested.)

This action should not be considered as a substitution for the individuals own responsibility to contact public health officials for more detailed contract tracing.

Messiah Lutheran Church Reopening

Members, visitors and guests who do not feel well or have any COVID-19 *symptoms, must not attend services, events, or other activities at the facility and are strongly encouraged to stay home. Members, visitors and guests are also strongly encouraged to stay home if they have a household member experiencing symptoms compatible with COVID-19.

*Symptoms can include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell. Other less common symptoms include gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

- 1. Members must not exceed 150 per worship service.
- 2. Weather permitting, ushers will open doors for congregation members so they do not have to touch the door handles.
- 3. Masks must be worn at all times.
- 4. We encourage members age 65 and above and those with underlying health issues to please partake the service via the radio broadcast or Facebook Live.
- 5. Congregation members will stop at a hand sanitizing station before entering the Narthex and Sanctuary.
- 6. There will be no coffee/treats after church.
- 7. Congregation members will sit with their immediate family members only with 6 feet between other families per social distancing guidelines. Every other pew will be roped off to help facilitate this transaction.
- 8. Bulletins will be available. If members choose, they can also view the bulletins on their personal phones or the overhead projector. All the hymnals will be removed. Please take your bulletins home for important church announcements.
- 9. Singing will be kept to a minimum. Special music may be performed within the social distancing guidelines.
- 10. Communion may be offered with prepackaged kits and distributed with the appropriate use of PPE.
- 11. Offering to be dropped off on the way out of the sanctuary to limit touch points.
- 12. Members must leave the church building promptly. If you would like to talk to other members, please do so outside wearing masks and maintaining social distancing guidelines.

Other considerations:

- 1. The water fountain will not be available for use.
- 2. Mics and other high touch areas must be disinfected after each use.
- 3. The bathrooms by the kitchen will be open for use. Members are encouraged to use hand sanitizer before entering and upon exiting the restroom.
- 4. If Sanctuary is to be used within the week, pews must be sanitized after the service.
