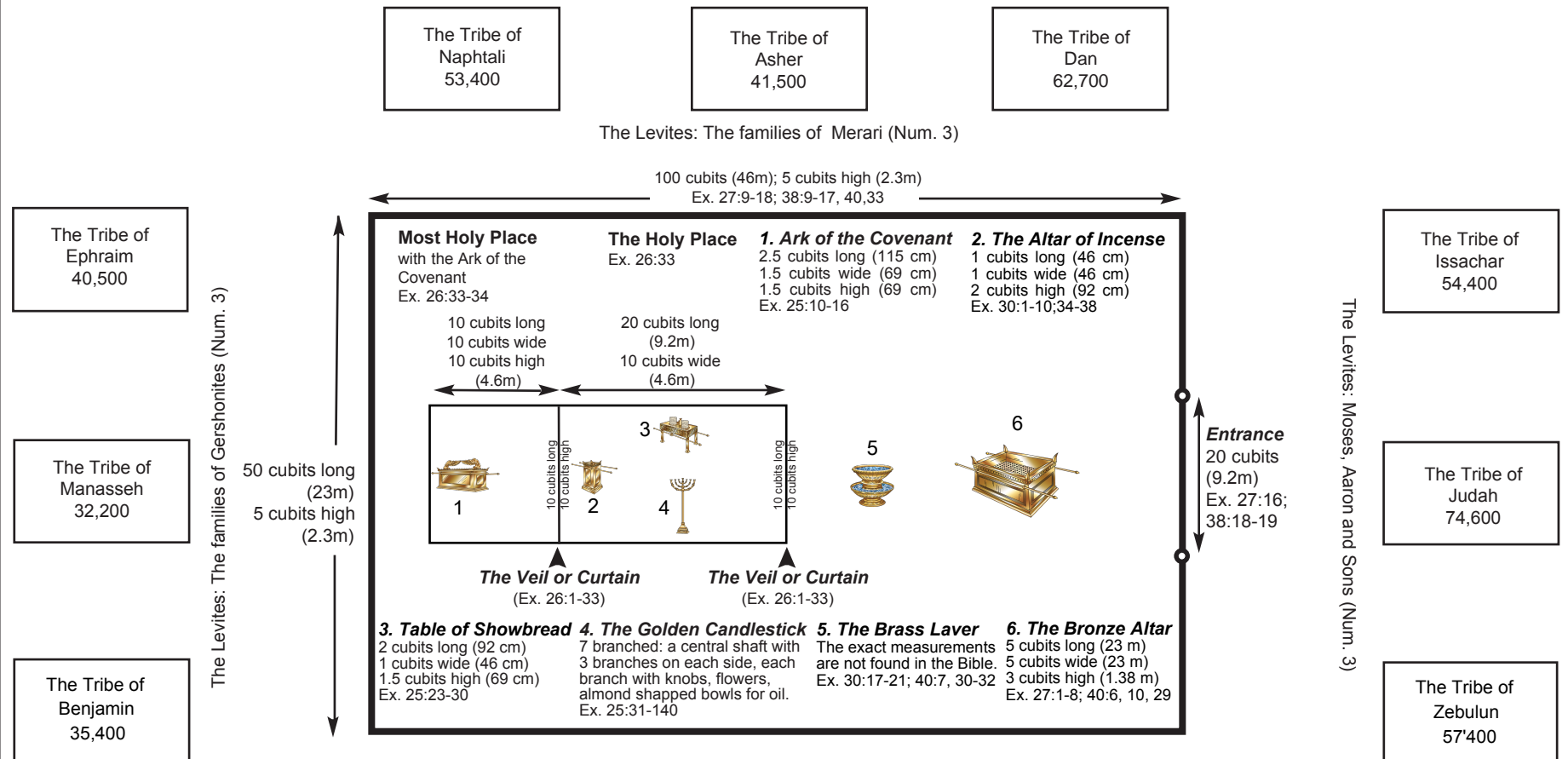


The Tabernacle

Built ~1446 B.C. for forgiveness and relationship with God.

The Tabernacle belongs to the new Covenant established with the ultimate sacrifice of the Lord Jesus Christ.



Contents of the Ark of the Covenant:
-Stone tablets of the 10 Commandments (Ex. 25:1; Deut. 10:5)
-A jar of Manna (Ex. 16:32-34)
-Aaron's Almond Rod that budded (Num.17:8, 10)

The tabernacle was built with gold, silver, bronze, precious woods, rare cloth - all paid by the Israelites. (Ex. 35:22-36:3)

The Israelites were so generous that Moses had to command them to stop giving. (Ex. 36:6)

The Levites: The families of Kohath (Num. 3)

The figures in the boxes refer to the number of males age 20 or over in each tribe. The total was 603,550.
