User instructions

Before use. Seek advice and familiarise yourself with the equipment. Do not use any equipment that is damaged. Please report any damage or unserviceability. Always fit the 2-part lid before starting the extraction.

In Use. Using the fittings provided, bolt the body of the extractor to the platform to stabilise it. Position the frames in the stainless-steel rack to 'balance the rotor'.

After use. Unlike many extractors, this one does not have a ball-bearing below the shaft. It can be taken apart by removing the 4 wing-nuts on the top rim and lifting the rotor out. Do not use any abrasive or chemical cleaners.

Washing.

- 1. Leave inverted to drain in a warm place.
- 2. COLD WATER wash using a hand-held spray (or high-pressure washer outdoors).
- 3. Repeat until clean, finishing off with warm water.
- * * Warm water melts the wax over the honey, making it difficult to dissolve. Do not put the extractor out for the bees to clean! This spreads disease and encourages robbing.
