- 2. Minutes of 30th AGM (2011) approved.
- 3. Nothing arising.
- 4. Chairman's Report: the chairman reported that generally 2012 had been a bad year for beekeeping. Nevertheless, the association had 114 members, with 309 hives accounted for, possibly more. The Summer Experience course had been hugely successful. Summer meetings had been well attended. The association apiary now had 10 hives and the association's finances were in good health. He thanked the committee for their drive and enthusiasm and urged other members to come forward and help spread the work load.
- 5. Treasurer's Report: a loss of £185 was reported. Currently, the association holds £3070 spread across deposit, current and petty cash accounts. £144 had been received in donations from members. We are still awaiting a response from M. Sheasby for a request for a grant for equipment. If the grant had been received, then loss would not have occurred. Significant expenditure was made on hive parts for apiary (£597). Summer experience brought in £380 (£410), honey sales made £704 (and increase of £279 over last year). Membership fees to be same as last year. Accounts to be audited immediately.
