The Vision for the consecration is to follow the leading of God in aligning ourselves with His will and being spiritually empowered to handle the business of the kingdom.

Every member of our church family and friends are encouraged to take this opportunity to draw closer to the Lord and get a spiritual breakthrough in your life.

Biblical examples of those who fasted show they were specific about their reasons for doing so – you should do so as well. The consecration will begin 6:00 a.m., Monday, January 4, 2021 and continue one day at a time for 21 days. We will conclude the consecration on Sunday, January 24, 2021 following the Morning Virtual Services. You are encouraged to follow the instructions given pertaining to the consecration.

If there are any questions regarding the personal adherence to the consecration, please discuss them with Pastor Kenan.

FASTING SCHEDULE 21 DAYS OF FASTING AND PRAYING JANUARY 4 – 24, 2021

Fasting and praying is a common practice in Christianity. When Jesus was talking with His disciples He taught them about fasting. It was expected that His disciples would fast (Matt. 6:6-18). The bible has examples of one, three, seven, and forty day fasts. (Judges 20:26; Esther 4:16; 1 Sam. 31:13 and Matt. 4 respectively). You should enter your consecration with fasting and praying.

During this time of fasting:

- 1. Consider your schedule.
- 2. Tell only the people you must. (Matt. 6)
- 3. Wean yourself off caffeine.
- 4. Avoid Media, Radio, TV, Facebook, etc.
- 5. Disconnect from people.
- 6. Beware of your emotions.
- 7. Rest.
- 8. Stay physically active.
- 9. Be still and focus on God.
- 10. Take time to study the Word, meditate and pray.

Each day will go as follows:

- 1. Fasting will be each day starting at 6:00 a.m. 3:00 p.m.
 - a. After 3:00 p.m. you may eat fresh fruits, vegetables, chicken or fish
 - b. No fried foods, no red meat or pork, no breads or sweets, no caffeine or soda, water only.
 - c. DO NOT OVEREAT, etc.
- 2. **For those with health restrictions, please follow the guidelines of your physician for diet and medication.**
- 3. Corporate Prayer will be virtual on the following nights: **January 6th, 13th, and 20th** at 7:00 p.m.
- 4. Those desiring to have oil blessed during the consecration should bring it and turn in to the office prior to January 20th. Please make sure it is labeled.
