BWPC WESTERN DRESSAGE - OPEN - TEST 1 REQUIREMENTS ENTRY NO:

This test introduces collection, engagement and lateral balance. The horse is asked to show that it has developed impulsion and improved balance and is beginning to develop self-carriage and engagement.

The horse's suppleness and harmony with the rider is important. The jog may be ridden at a Sitting or Rising trot but not a combination of both. Working Jog & Walk Free Walk 20 m & 10m circles at a working jog 20m circle at a lope 360 degree turns on forehand Back up 4-6 steps
