

Messiah Lutheran Church Reopening

Members, visitors and guests who do not feel well or have any COVID-19 *symptoms, must not attend services, events, or other activities at the facility and are strongly encouraged to stay home. Members, visitors and guests are also strongly encouraged to stay home if they have a household member experiencing symptoms compatible with COVID-19.

*Symptoms can include fever, cough, shortness of breath, chills, headache, muscle pain, sore throat, or loss of taste or smell. Other less common symptoms include gastrointestinal symptoms like nausea, vomiting, or diarrhea.

- 1. Members must not exceed 150 per worship service.
- 2. Weather permitting, ushers will open doors for congregation members so they do not have to touch the door handles.
- 3. Masks must be worn at all times.
- 4. We encourage members age 65 and above and those with underlying health issues to please partake the service via the radio broadcast or Facebook Live.
- 5. Congregation members will stop at a hand sanitizing station before entering the Narthex and Sanctuary.
- 6. There will be no coffee/treats after church.
- 7. Congregation members will sit with their immediate family members only with 6 feet between other families per social distancing guidelines. Every other pew will be roped off to help facilitate this transaction.
- 8. Bulletins will be available. If members choose, they can also view the bulletins on their personal phones or the overhead projector. All the hymnals will be removed. Please take your bulletins home for important church announcements.
- 9. Singing will be kept to a minimum. Special music may be performed within the social distancing guidelines.
- 10. Communion may be offered with prepackaged kits and distributed with the appropriate use of PPE.
- 11. Offering to be dropped off on the way out of the sanctuary to limit touch points.
- 12. Members must leave the church building promptly. If you would like to talk to other members, please do so outside wearing masks and maintaining social distancing guidelines.

Other considerations:

- 1. The water fountain will not be available for use.
- 2. Mics and other high touch areas must be disinfected after each use.
- 3. The bathrooms by the kitchen will be open for use. Members are encouraged to use hand sanitizer before entering and upon exiting the restroom.
- 4. If Sanctuary is to be used within the week, pews must be sanitized after the service.

Hello Messiah/MOE Families! What a crazy Spring & Summer we had living in this Pandemic and doing everything we can to Stay connected with our church families and provide safe and impactful ministry programming! After meeting with Councils and Youth committees of both churches our plan is to do in person Youth Ministry starting in middle of Sept (See Youth Calendar) Below is our Messiah/Moe Youth Ministry In person Guidelines we will be following! We also will be following the Roseau School Schedule and what the Covid Cases will be on a month to month basis! For sure we will be having 4-6 Grade and 7-12 Grade youth groups, confirmation classes, To Go Confirmation Suppers, 10-12 Grade Grab & Go Lunch Ministry, Monday Night Family Campfire Worships & Friday Night Movie Nights for now! While writing this report, I still don't know exactly what the plan is for Sunday School this fall and if there will be Release Time offered from School this fall, when I know, I'll let you know, other groups make final decisions for Sunday School and Release Time! For September programming we will try to be outside as much as we can for youth groups!

LISTED BELOW IS THE GUIDELINES OUR YOUTH MINISTRY WILL BE FOLLOWING THIS FALL!

Messiah and Moe youth who do not feel well or have any COVID 19 symptoms are encouraged to stay home and get well! We will get you make up work for Confirmation Classes and for youth group we might do some Facebook lives that you can watch from home if not feeling well! We also suggest for youth to stay home if a family member is experiencing symptoms compatible with

- 1. Must not exceed 150 youth in the sanctuary maintaining social 6ft or more distancing
- 2. There will be no snacks or coffee/hot chocolate in the youth room! Temporarily there will be no Keurigs being used or video games Charging stations will not be available during pandemic and we are asking youth to not use phones unless emergency for sanitization safety purposes!
- 3. Water fountain will not be available for use (We are looking into purchasing a water fountain that fills water bottles)
- 4. Confirmation will use fellowship hall, education wing and youth rooms for classes! If class size is bigger than 10, they will be spread out accordingly! We will be social distancing in each room
- Masks MUST be worn at all times while inside the church building
- 6. Weather permitting, we will be using outdoor church property as much as possible in the fall season
- 7. There will be a half hour time period of cleaning/sanitizing after a room has been occupied before being used again that day
- To honor #7 listed above, 7-12 Grade Moessiah youth group will always begin in the Sanctuary to allow time for cleaning in the other end of church after confirmation classes
- 9. When entering and exiting the church building, the youth are encouraged to use the hand sanitizing stations that will be in entry way and other parts of church! When entering the building they must have their masks on before entering! There will be an adult at the door to greet and ensure the youth use the sanitizing machines! The Adult Volunteers will have gloves on to ensure they are the only ones who touch the door handles!
- 10. When youth groups are finished, youth are encouraged to leave building with no hang out time. Parents, please pick up your kids promptly at 5 pm, 6:45 or 8:15 pm the end times for Elementary youth groups, confirmation and 7-12 Grade youth group
- 11. Temporarily there will be no use of phones during youth group, please keep them in your bags or pockets at all times while in the church building!
- 12. If your child forgets to bring a mask, we will have extra disposable masks on hand so the youth can stay in building
- 13. Confirmation Time Out Suppers will be provided this year but will be Take Out Containers that made up ahead of time and each youth grabs container and drink and eats outside or inside spread out with no more than 3 to a table and wash hands before and after eating! Only time masks can be off is to eat but once done eating masks will be needed to be put on right away, thanks!

These Guidelines are like a live document where changes can be made to them at anytime depending on the active cases in Roseau County or if any exposure to covid at the church! Any Questions please give me a call and we will need lots of Adult volunteers on Wed nights for making of the to go suppers and for helping keep our youth safe and able to grow in their faith in God doing it safely but together as ONE IN THE BODY OF CHRIST!!!
