Bishop Trevor Edwards

Dear sisters and brothers,

This week the Synod of this Diocese meets to elect our next Archbishop following the retirement of the Most Reverend Glenn Davies in late March. Four worthy candidates have consented to be nominated and scrutinised for this highly important leadership position. Given the size of the Synod being nominated is not for the fainthearted. There will be speeches by Synod members for and against each candidate in which their strengths and work areas may be dissected before voting takes place in various stages until only one is elected.

I have known each of the candidates for a long period of time. All love and trust Christ and have many fine gifts which have been previously exercised very well in a variety of different ministry settings. So I want you to pray for all of them and their families this week, that God will keep them in perfect peace during this process from which they are excluded. The candidates are Christopher Edwards (Bishop of North Sydney), Peter Hayward (Bishop of Wollongong), Kanishka Raffel (Dean of Sydney) and Michael Stead (Bishop of South Sydney).

The second crucial prayer point is to pray for the Synod itself that it will conduct itself in a way which pleases God. Make it a priority to pray that all the members of Synod will do the following things -

a) Listen Attentively

Even though they might have already formed a view on the basis of the material they have received, it is crucial for them to keep listening to God as he speaks through the insights of their sisters and brothers in this corporate discernment process. In my opinion it is wise to suspend judgement and be open to having their views modified or changed.

b) Speak Respectfully

The Diocese is really blessed to have four people of this calibre in discernment who have willingly exposed themselves to intense scrutiny. Synod members need to avoid the sin of character assassination when speaking about them. It is far too easy to magnify weaknesses at the expense of strengths, just as it is to over-inflate strengths to give the wrong impression. Pray that members will speak carefully and respectfully.

c) Assess Soberly

In such a large setting it is also relatively easy to be swayed by prejudice or persuasive speech, so members need to keep their minds and wits engaged to keep seeking the person who best fits the current and future needs of our whole Diocese not just their sectional interest.

d) Decide Prayerfully

Above all please pray that the Synod members will decide prayerfully, seeking the mind of God in this huge decision about who is best placed to become our chief under Shepherd in this Diocese for the glory of God and the benefit of his people.
