

TREASURER'S REPORT

Thanks to all the support from families and friends, we had an amazing 2012/13 school year! We were able to bring in a net of \$67,131.62 through active fundraisers (like cookie sales, mixed bags, and the jog- and dance-a-thons) and passive fundraisers (like Box Tops, eScrip, restaurant flier nights, and store loyalty programs). PTA gave back to the students and community and spent a net of \$63,193.00 to sponsor all of the events and activities our community enjoys. These events and activities included school community events (like movie nights, harvest festival, and bingo), the AR program, our art and music docent programs, scholarships for field trips and spirit wear, classroom enrichment funds for every teacher on campus, 3 grade level assemblies (like the Walk Throughs), and new playground equipment. The PTA also hosted a week-long staff appreciation event, and took care of operating costs (copies, accounting software, insurance, etc...). In summary, last year's financial results have allowed us to create a budget this year that will include all of the programs and activities we have provided last year plus additional items like the Assemblies for the K-2 students and other exciting surprises you will see as the year progresses. It also allows us to accommodate some of the continually increasing costs like the AR program licenses. Special thanks to our budget committee that made all of this happen: PTA members Adam Roberts, Mindee Gilmer, Isabel Bennett, Tammy Coghill, Peggy Larson, and Kim Rauh, and many more behind the scenes for their input through a series of budget meetings/emails this spring and summer. We would also like to thank all past and present PTA board members for their involvement. We are blessed to have a fantastic school for our stu-

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
