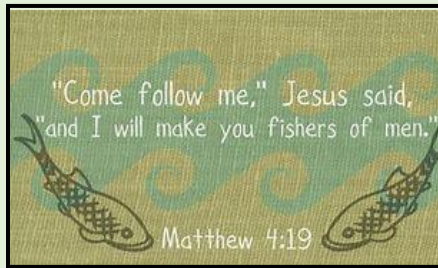

***Spiritual Study...* Fr Swann offers a six-session spiritual study on St Joseph.**

You are encouraged to read a book titled "Through the Heart of St. Joseph" written by Fr. Boniface Hicks, OSB. You may purchase an e-book at Amazon.ca. But it is not necessary to have a book or read it ahead. Fr Swann will cover each chapter at each session (a total of six chapters).
