Problem Solving Script:

1: State the problem in one sentence:
"I've noticed you're having a hard time with What's up?"
2: Empathize with your kid:
Repeat what your child has said. Ask questions. "When it's time for, what
do you start thinking?" "What else?" "Walk me through this."
3. State your concern:
"The thing is"
4: Invite them to solve the problem:
"How can we solve this problem?"

Remember:

- Choose one small, solvable problem to start.
- Be a detective.
- Prioritize. Let some problems go.
- Be proactive: pick the moment wisely.

Troubleshooting: Repeat empathy. Be patient. Self-regulate.

This takes time to learn, and time to build trust. Start simply, with fewer words and more empathy.
