Point 2: Current State

We need more guys to step up! Yes, the majority of our brothers are not embracing the BOND of being TKE. This does not mean every person steps up every week or even every month. With 1300+ members we must distribute the responsibilities if we are going to be a world class organization. Right now we have a small pocket, a single handful of brothers stepping up. But, as we have seen in the past placing this responsibility upon the same group of guy's day in, day out will not achieve our goals.

The <u>top 3 responses</u> fraters having given for not coming out to events or getting more involved are as follows: "I have plans" or "I just don't have time" or "I will in the future"

Trivia 2- What is a scroll captain?

Brothers, now is the time to step forward. We are not scheduling events at the last minute and each year you know dues are requested. Most of these events are known a year in advance. If this will succeed we need each of you to 1.) Pick at least one event per year to attend and be involved in. 2.) Volunteer to assist in working a TKE event OR updating fraters contact information OR playing a leadership role in the alumni association OR offer ways that you can assist by asking the President how you can help.

TKE is not asking for you to prioritize TKE over family, career, personal or religious portions of your life. But, TKE is asking to be a small part of your regular life. This takes planning in advance and a want to be involved.

As you will read in the next section (Point 3) you will see we have an immediate need for (2) officers and (16) scroll captains. Additionally, we will need guys to plan ahead to support our events in 2013 by setting up, working the event and take down after the event. Each of these roles are very different and require various levels of support ranging from 1-hr per year to 4-8 hrs per month. Presently, the persons filling these roles are every bit as busy as you. The difference is they have made a sacrifice and a commitment to put TKE back in their life.

Level 2 - Apollo Frater (Alumni Volunteer)
Volunteer for at least 1 event + above

Level 3 - Fraternity for Life Frater (Alumni Leader)
Serve as an officer or captain + above
