Have you heard of Celiac Disease (CD)? 1 out of every 133 American adults and children have this under-diagnosed immune-mediated disorder that directly affects the gastrointestinal tract, when gluten is ingested. Left untreated, this disorder may cause other problems to arise, such as other autoimmune disorders, malabsorption, vitamin deficiencies, osteoporosis, infertility, neurological damage, and cancer. In the U.S., it takes an average of 11 years to be properly diagnosed with CD. Why? CD is thought to be rare and many doctors do not consider testing patients for it.
