- Lake AIS Treatment
 - Treated 15 acres of Curlyleaf Pondweed
 - Eurasian Water Milfoil
 - Checked and have not found it
 - Will check in September and treat if found.
 - Treated 1 acre of Starry Stonewart
 - Divers surveyed, pulled, Cutrine plus application at County landing
 - Early August Found a couple of handfuls with no spread
 - Will do a survey and dive on both landings in September
 - Whole lake survey in September
 - Will concentrate on Eurasian Water Milfoil and Starry Stonewart


Water Quality Fund Raising Campaign

- This is year 3 of our 5 year campaign to raise \$125,000 (\$25,000/year).
- Second year (2019) \$15,490 from members plus \$5000 from the City.
- So far in 2020, only 69% of our members have contributed \$9,988. We need your help to move that percentage to at least 75% by December 31st.
- Remember PLIA's 501(c)(3) status when considering your 2020 charitable giving.
- Please consider your employer's Matching Gift program to double or perhaps triple your donation.
- QCDs via RMDs from your IRAs = a Win/Win for YOU and the PLIA.
 - A Qualified Charitable Contribution (QCD) is a tax free transfer.
 - Available even though your Required Minimum Distribution (RMD) from your Individual Retirement Account (IRA) is not required in 2020.
 - Consult your tax professional to make sure you do it correctly.

Summary

- 90% of annual expenses go directly to treatment of AIS and to cover our share of ramp inspection costs.
- The objective is to cover annual operating expenses with annual contributions plus build substantial reserves to fund an AIS emergency at any point in the future.
