

CHAPTER 218.

AN ACT TO AMEND CHAPTER THIRTY-SIX OF THE PRIVATE LAWS, EXTRA SESSION OF ONE THOUSAND NINE HUNDRED AND EIGHT, RELATING TO THE INCORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF BAILY'S, IN NASH COUNTY.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

SECTION 1. That chapter thirty-six of the Private Laws of one thousand nine hundred and eight, entitled "An act to incorporate the town of Baily's, in Nash County," be and the same is hereby amended by striking out all of section two (2) of said act and inserting in lieu thereof the following: "That the corporate limits of said town shall be as follows, to wit: Beginning at Albert Farmer's corner in J. E. Bragg's line; thence with said Bragg's line, Exum O'Neal's line, Mrs. J. C. O'Neal's line and A. R. Beard's line, to Noel Eatman's corner; thence with said Eatman's line and H. G. Stott's line and N. W. Williams' line to the Camp Branch; thence down the Camp Branch to the ford in the road; thence up the road to Albert Farmer's line; thence with Albert Farmer's line to the beginning." Corporate limits.

SEC. 2. That all laws and clauses of laws in conflict with this act are hereby repealed.

SEC. 3. That this act shall be in force from and after its ratification.

Ratified this the 1st day of March, 1911.

CHAPTER 219.

AN ACT TO CONSOLIDATE, REVISE AND AMEND THE CHARTER OF THE TOWN OF SMITHFIELD.

The General Assembly of North Carolina do enact:

SECTION 1. That the inhabitants of the town of Smithfield shall be, and continue as they have heretofore been, a body politic and corporate, and in the name of the town of Smithfield shall have perpetual succession, may use a common seal, shall have the right to sue and be sued, contract and be contracted with, to purchase, hold and convey real and personal property for the purpose of the government of the said town, its welfare and improvement, and, under the name and style aforesaid, are hereby invested with all the property and rights of every kind that now belong to the present corporation of the town of Smithfield, and shall also be liable for all debts, claims, obligations and duties which now exist against the corporation of the said town of Smithfield.
