### Spring Valley Update for November/December Newsleaf – 2021

Spring Valley's grounds and facilities will assume winter hours, starting November 1 (see below). The Park District to require all visitors to wear a mask when inside our facilities regardless of their vaccination status, in accordance with state of Illinois guidelines. Area schools have begun returning to Spring Valley for field trip programs, making things feel that much more normal. Meanwhile, we have begun bringing back some of our special events and continue to offer a full schedule of family, youth, and adult programs.

- Spring Valley's grounds and walking trails are open for walkers every day from 8am-5pm during the shorter days of late autumn and winter. Portable toilets are available near Merkle Cabin and Heritage Farm; the new restrooms near Bison's Bluff Nature Playground will soon be winterized and shut down until springtime.
- The gate leading onto Heritage Farm's walking paths from St. Matthew's Church will remain closed during the winter months, except during our scheduled Christmas event.
- The **Nature Center Museum** is now open to visitors Wednesday-Sunday from 10am-4pm. The restrooms, drinking fountain and vending will be opened every day for visitor use.
- Volkening Heritage Farm's Visitor Center, as well as the farmhouse, will remain open to visitors every Wednesday-Sunday from 10am-4pm through November only. Buildings will close for the winter on November 29.
- **Bison's Bluff Nature Playground** will remain open daily from 10am-4:00pm throughout the winter, except during snowy, icy or rainy weather. Admission is free during winter.
- A number of other programs and a holiday event will be offered between now and the New Year (see descriptions below).
- Volunteers continue to assist with outdoor conservation projects, trail maintenance, and with some of our
  modified events and programs. If you are willing and able to assist with projects, please contact Brenda

This year's version of our annual holiday event will feature demonstrations of 19<sup>th</sup> century holiday preparations, live music, food, and visits with St. Nick. All activities will take place at Heritage Farm and will mostly be outdoors. Parking is available at St. Matthew's Church. Admission fee is \$3/person or \$12/family.

#### Nature Printmaking Workshop – Sat., November 20, 10:00-11:30am

There will be hands-on participation for all ages, and everyone will leave with an artistic creation or two that they can use as a gift or natural keepsake. Pre-registration is required. Fee is \$20/resident family or \$24/non-resident family.

#### Monthly Mindfulness Hikes – Sun., November 14 & December 12, 9:00-10:30am

Explore Spring Valley's trails through the lens of mindfulness; enjoy the sights and sounds with a fresh perspective and make some nature art along the way. Ages 18 and above. Pre-registration required.

Fee is \$10/resident or \$12/non-resident.

Ellsworth founded the Spring Valley Nature Club in 1974 as a not-for-profit service organization which provides volunteer and financial support for Spring Valley and promotes conservation, nature, and environmental education.
