

# COVID-19 Studio Policy



## Attendance:

- Any students feeling unwell must stay home and not attend class.
- Absences are eligible for make-up classes if available.
- Parents must email absences to [dancealleyperformingarts@gmail.com](mailto:dancealleyperformingarts@gmail.com) on behalf of students under the age of 18 years.
- Your teacher will be informed of the absence and Miss Ali will facilitate a make-up class if available.

## Studio Safety:

We ask families to please minimise the need for face to face service as we have a limited number of people allowed in the building and we must prioritise staff and students. If you have questions, please email [dancealleyperformingarts@gmail.com](mailto:dancealleyperformingarts@gmail.com)

- No parents are permitted inside the studio. Students are to be dropped off and picked up at the entrance.
- Arrival time is to be no more than 5 minutes before class, to prevent loitering in waiting areas.
- Students are to arrive to class in their dance attire and avoid changing at the studio if it can be helped.
- Students must sanitise hands upon entry and exit of the studio. Sanitising stations are available at the entry of each studio.
- Students are to keep all their belongings with them at all times and are asked to not leave items in the waiting room.
- We ask students to minimise eating at DAPA if it can be helped. If students need to eat we ask they practise excellent hygiene.
- As dance is classified as a low contact sport, it is not required by the government for the students and teachers to be apart at all times. DAPA allows and maintains 4m square per student in every studio. DAPA requests students to maintain 1.5m physical distancing from each other where possible, in and out of class. That means no hugging, high-fiving or other forms of physical contact within the studios that are not essential.
